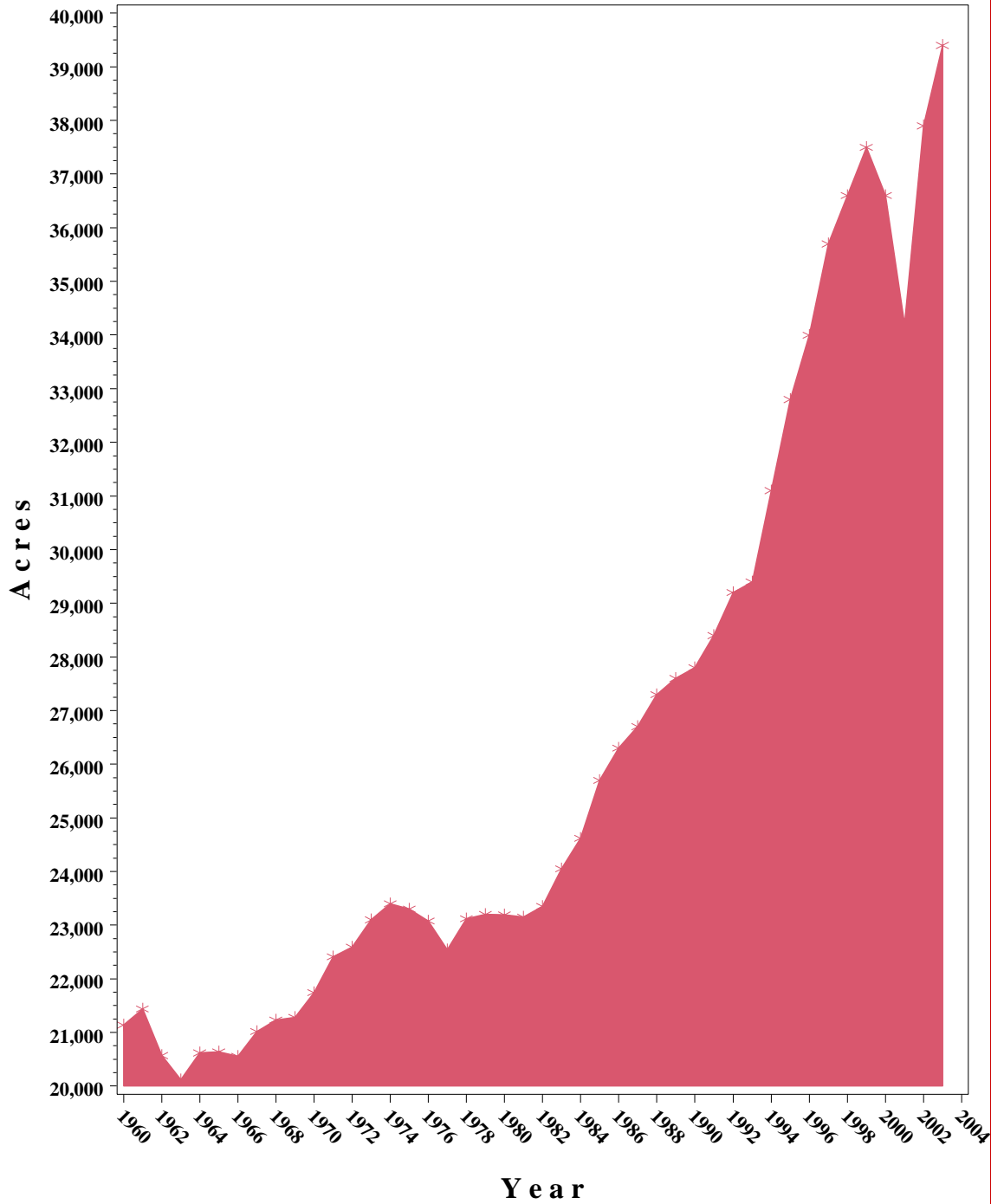

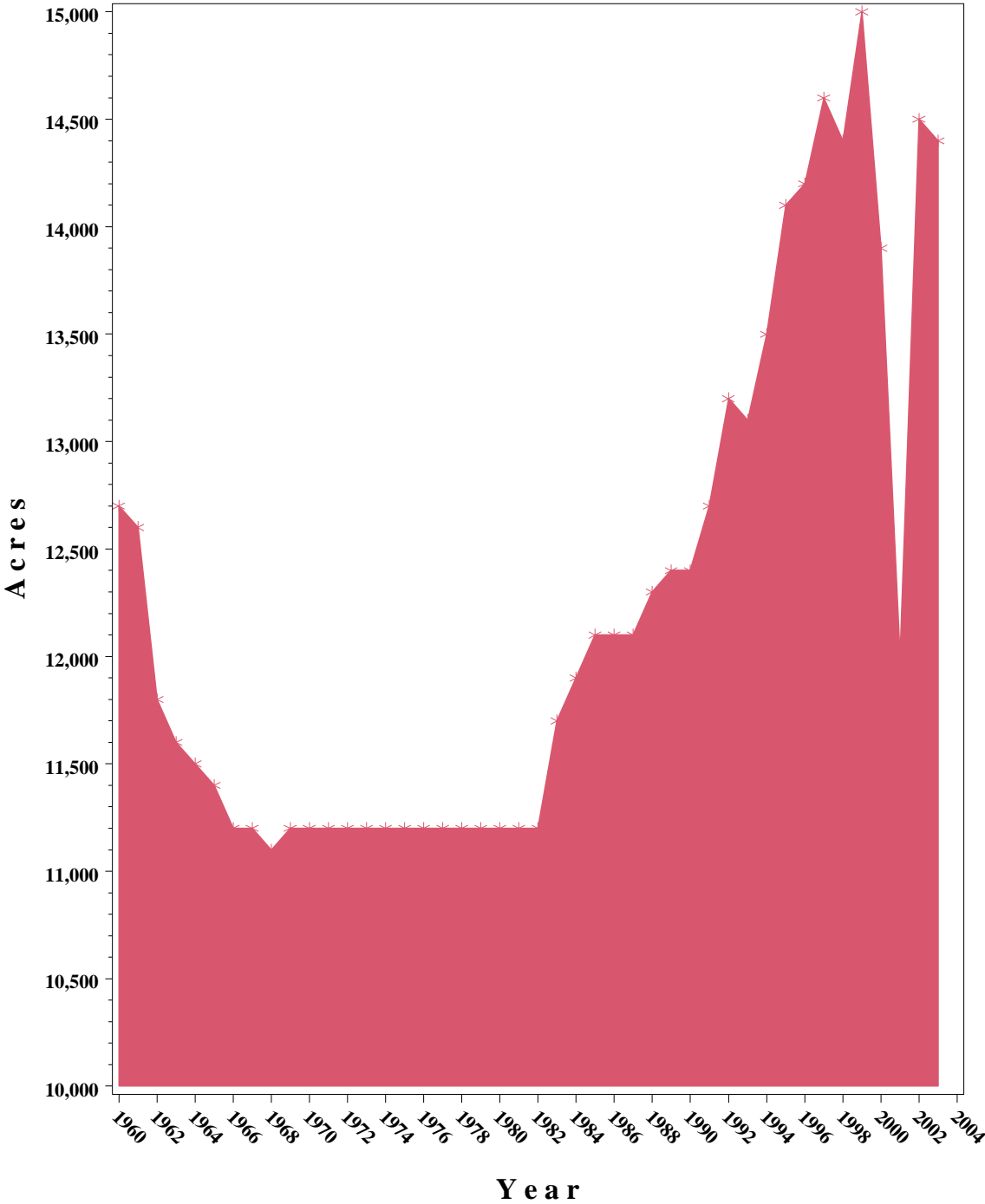

U.S. Cranberry Area Harvested 1960 - 2003



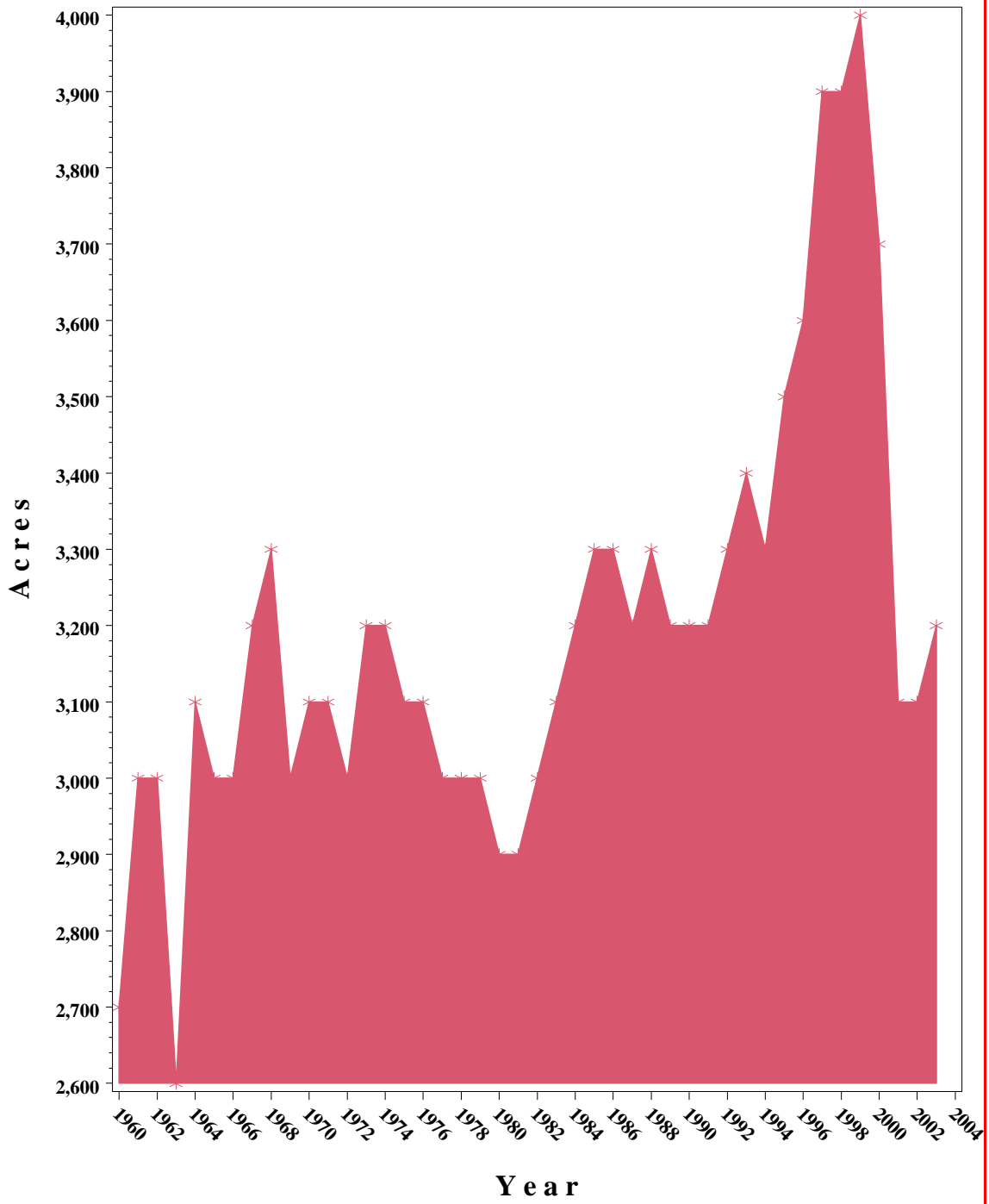

Massachusetts Cranberry Area Harvested 1960 - 2003



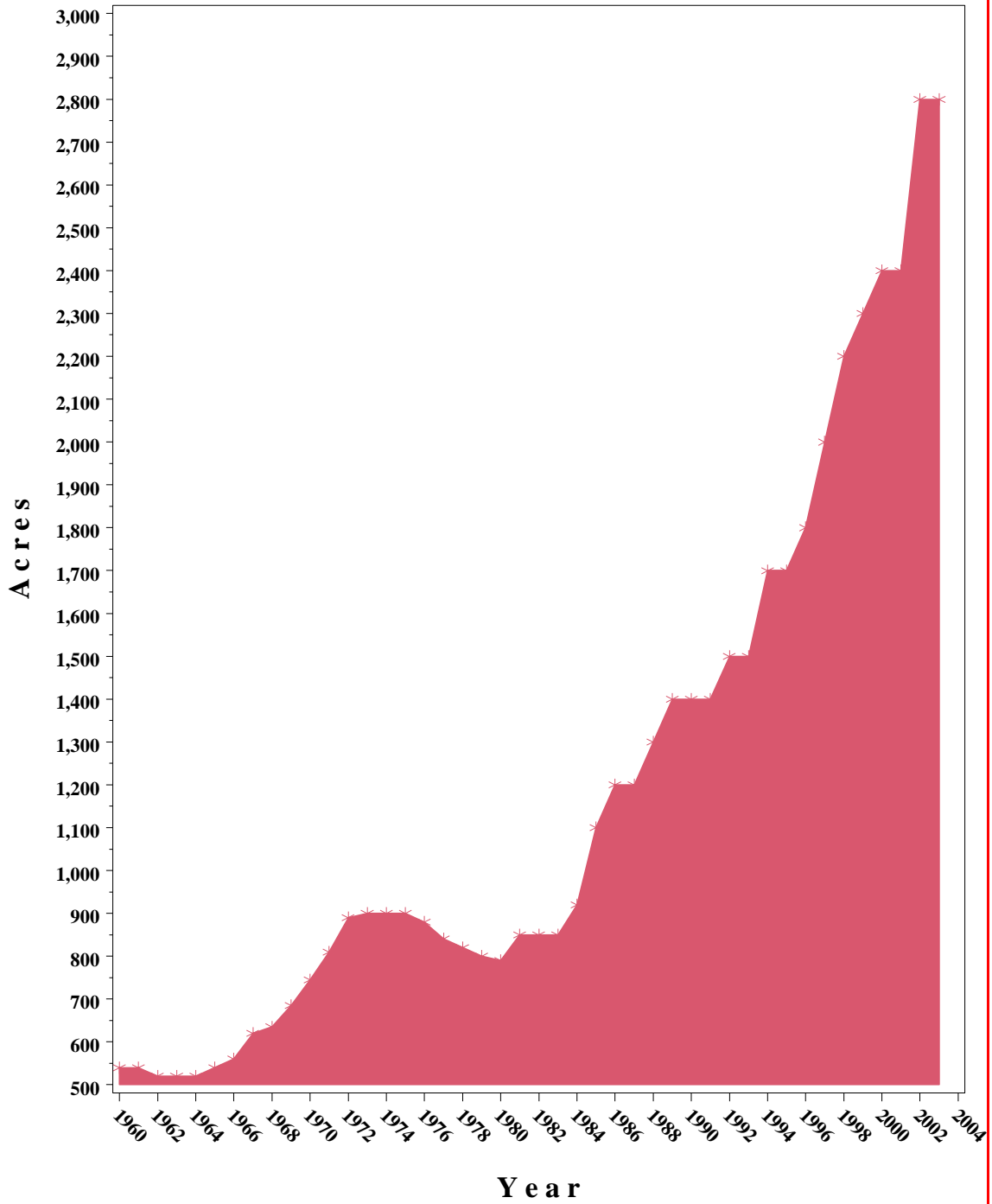

New Jersey Cranberry Area Harvested 1960 - 2003



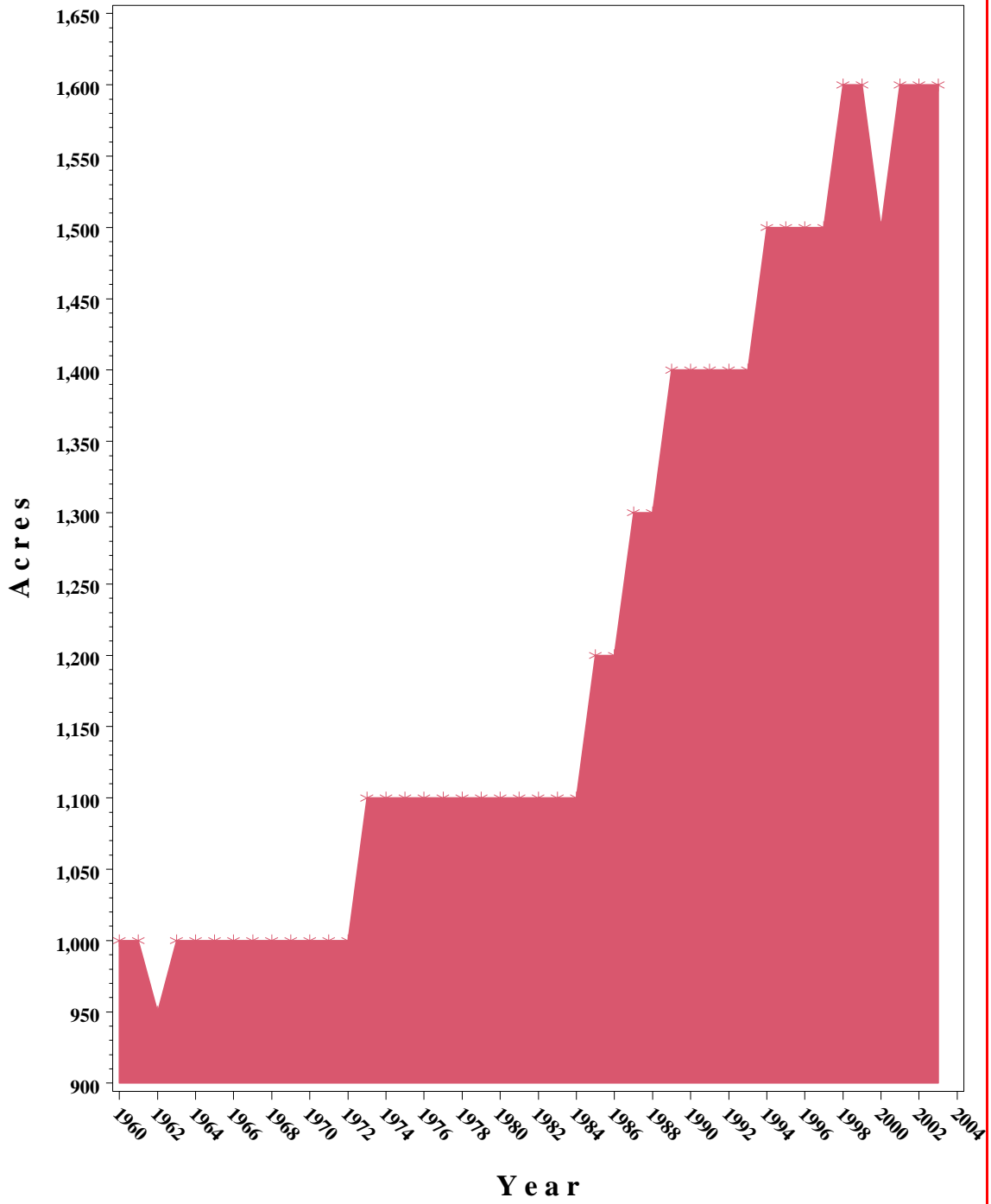

Oregon Cranberry Area Harvested 1960 - 2003



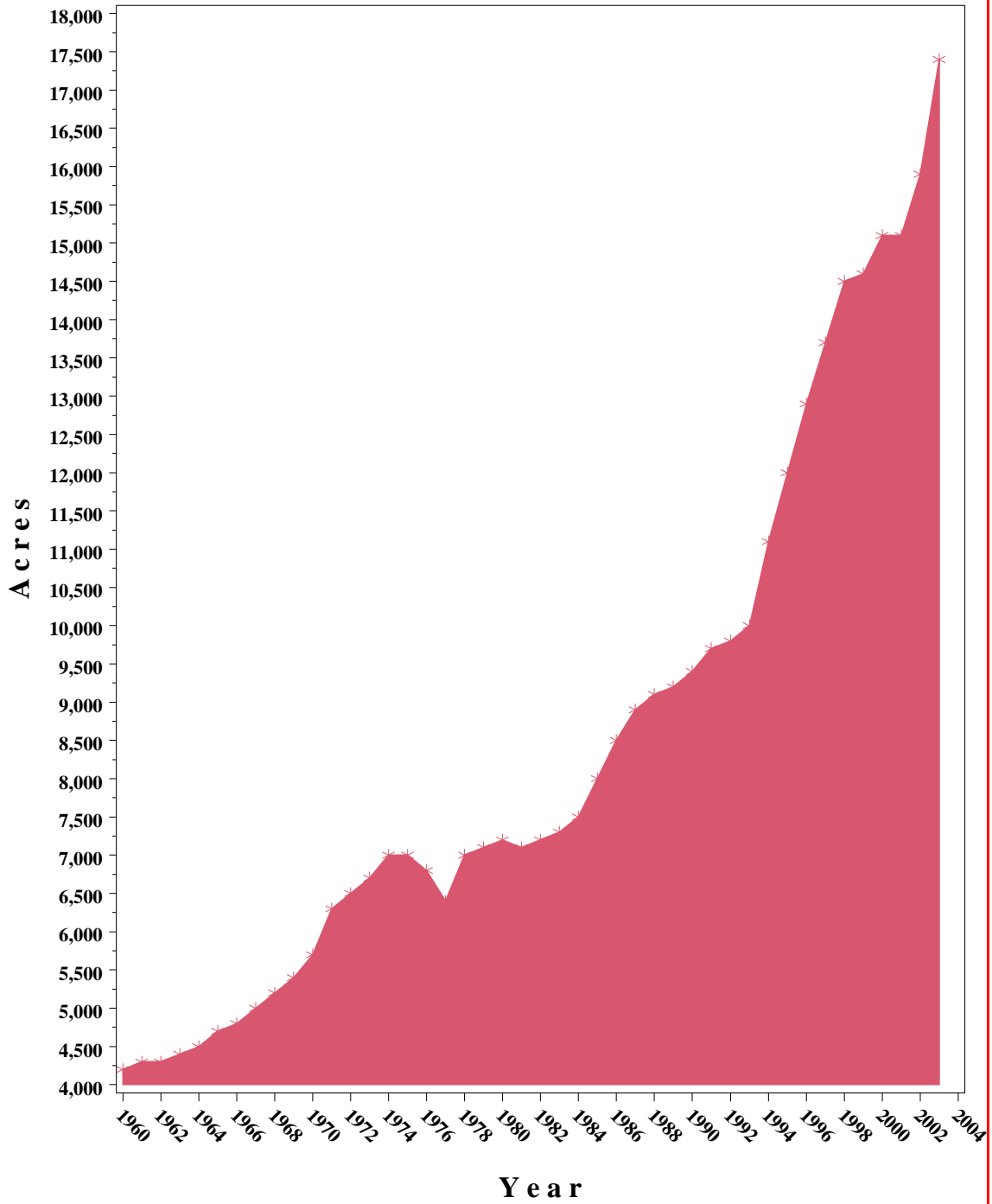

Washington Cranberry Area Harvested 1960 - 2003



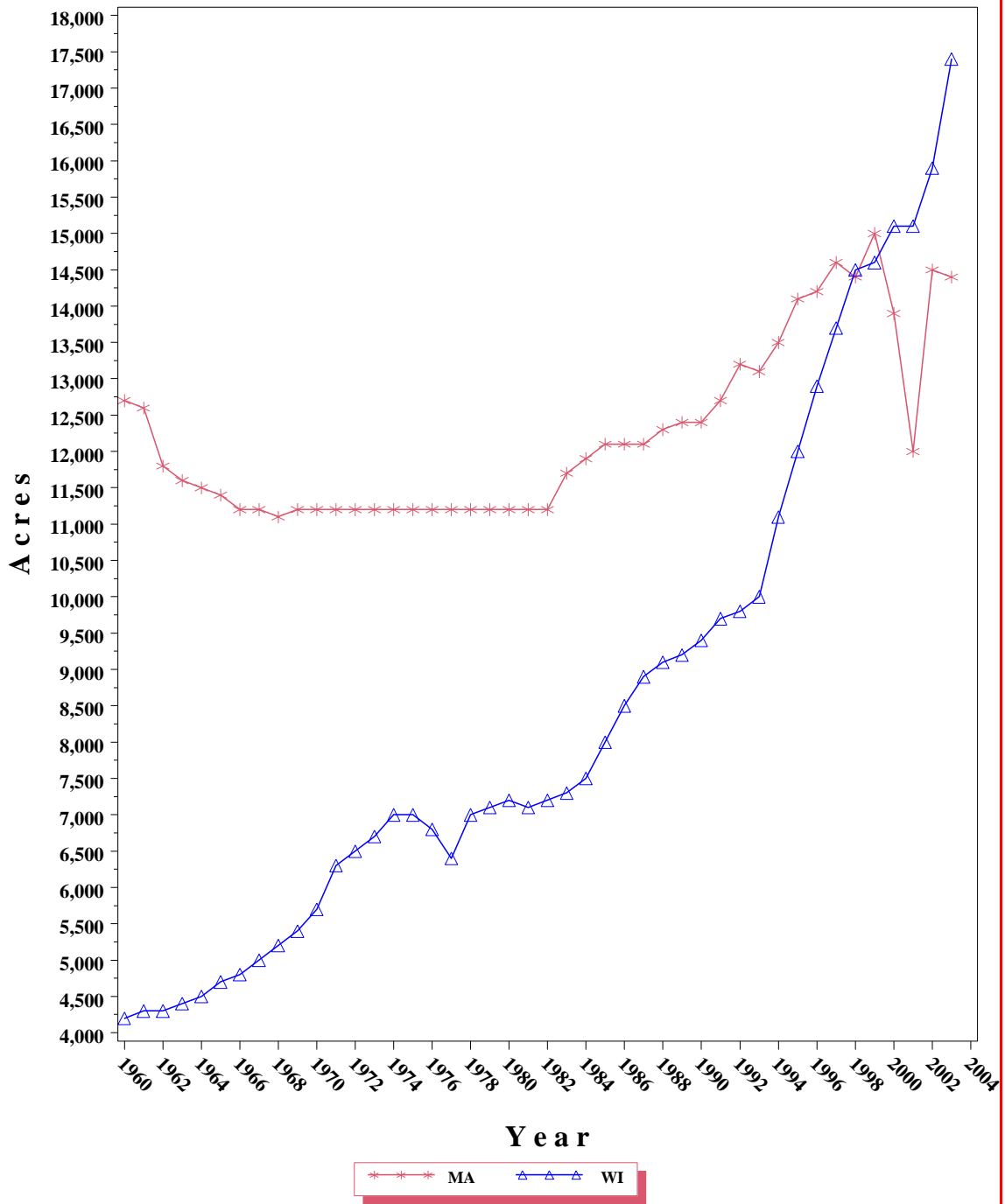

Wisconsin Cranberry Area Harvested 1960 - 2003



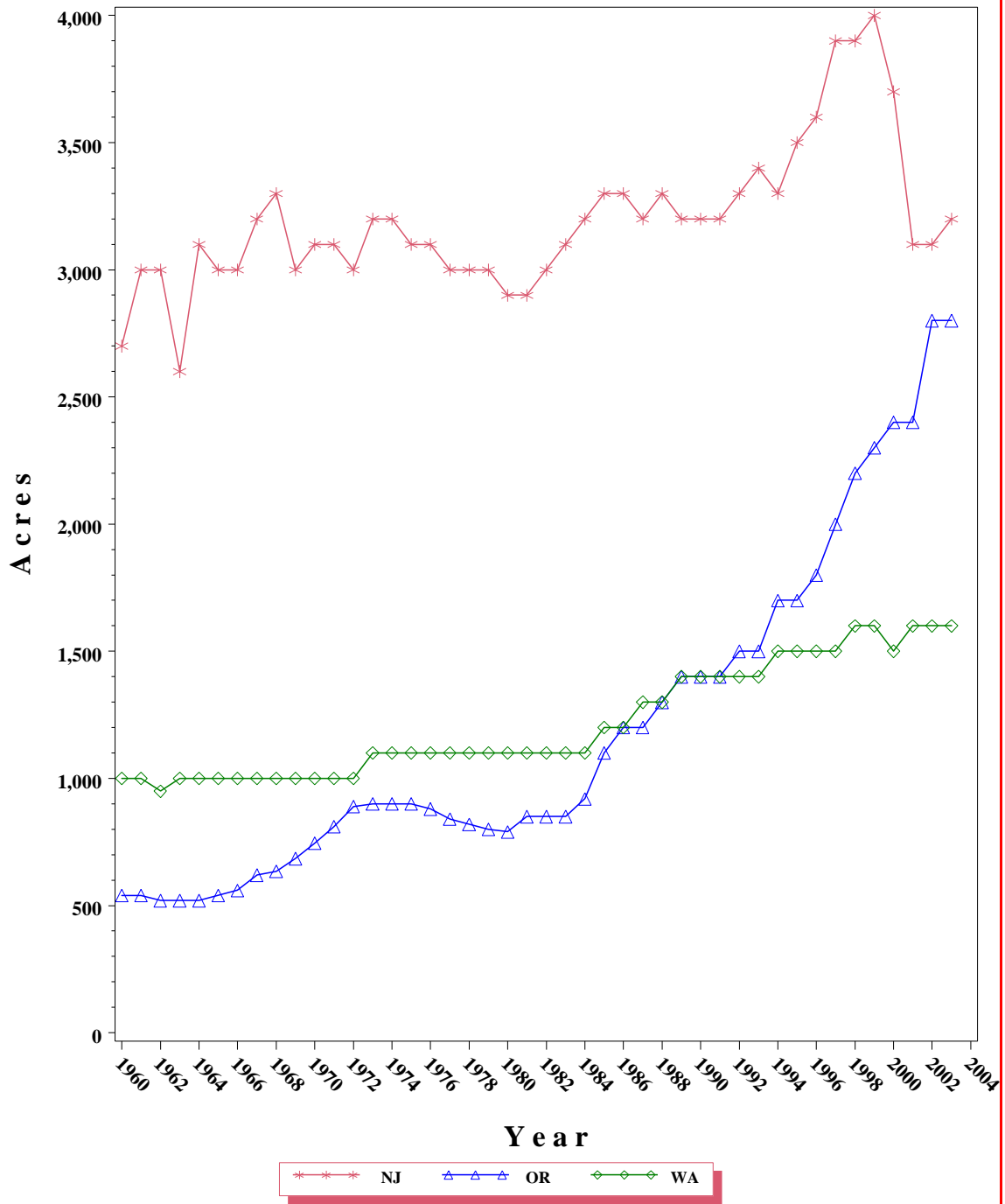

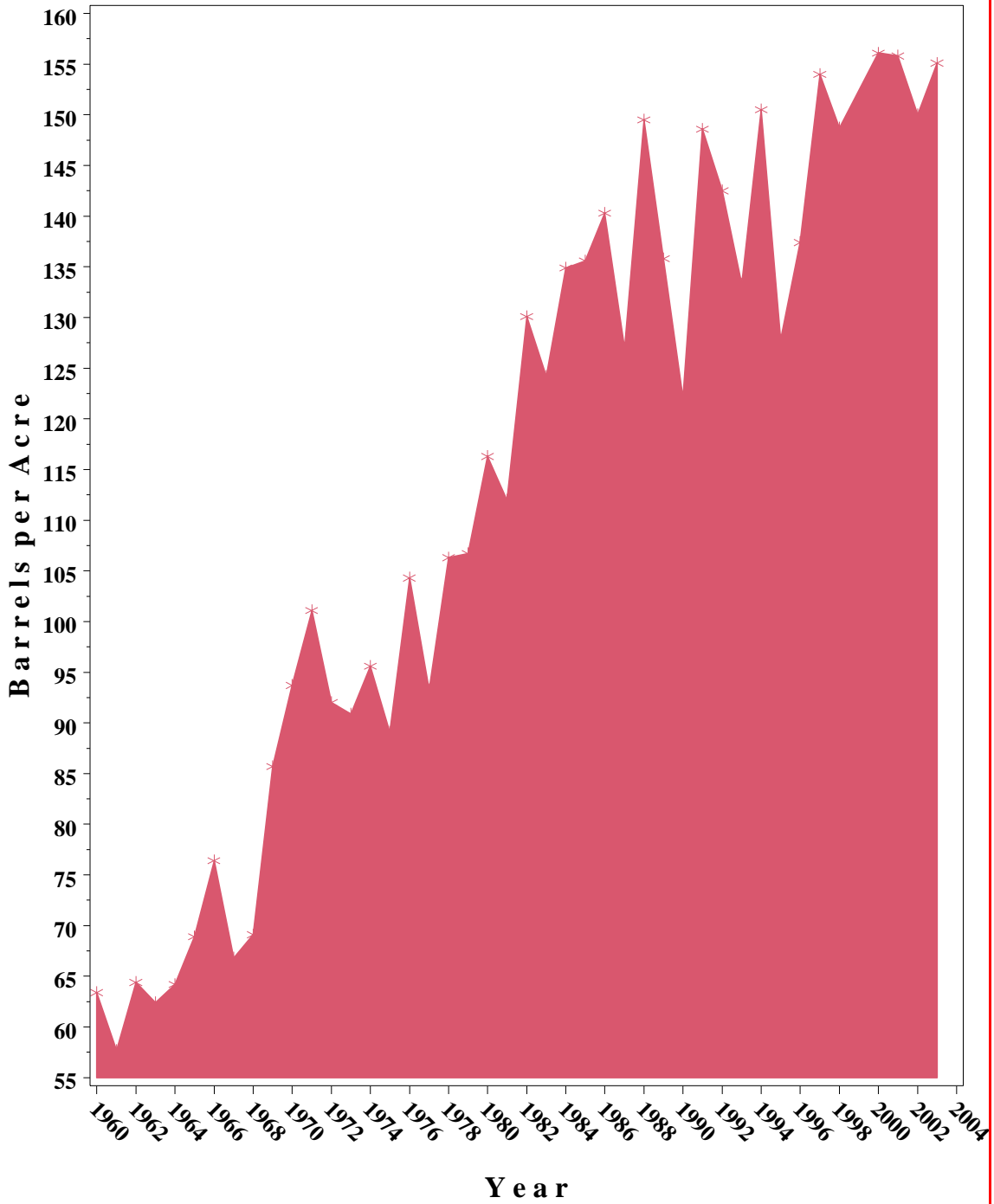

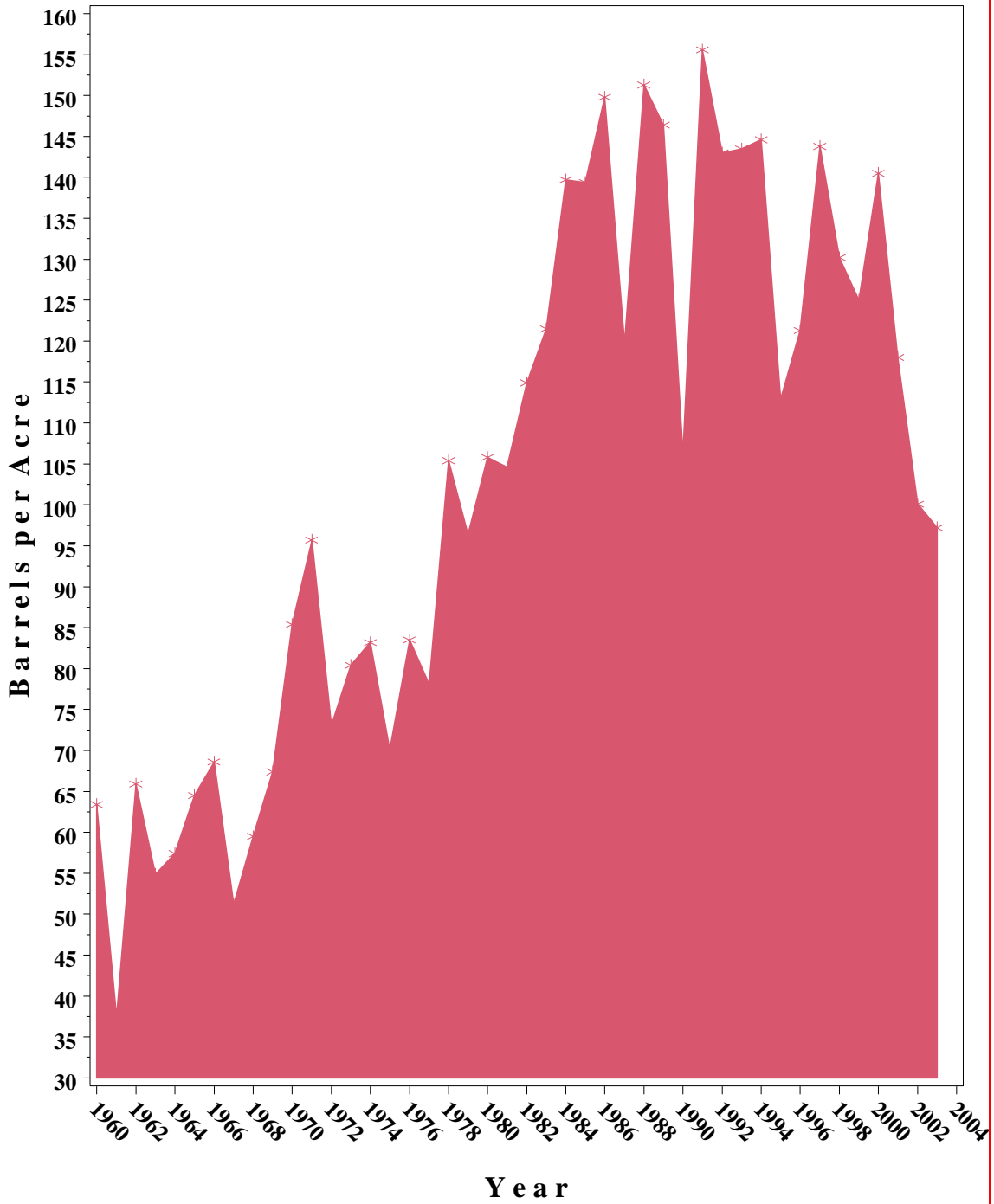

U.S. Cranberry Yield 1960 - 2003



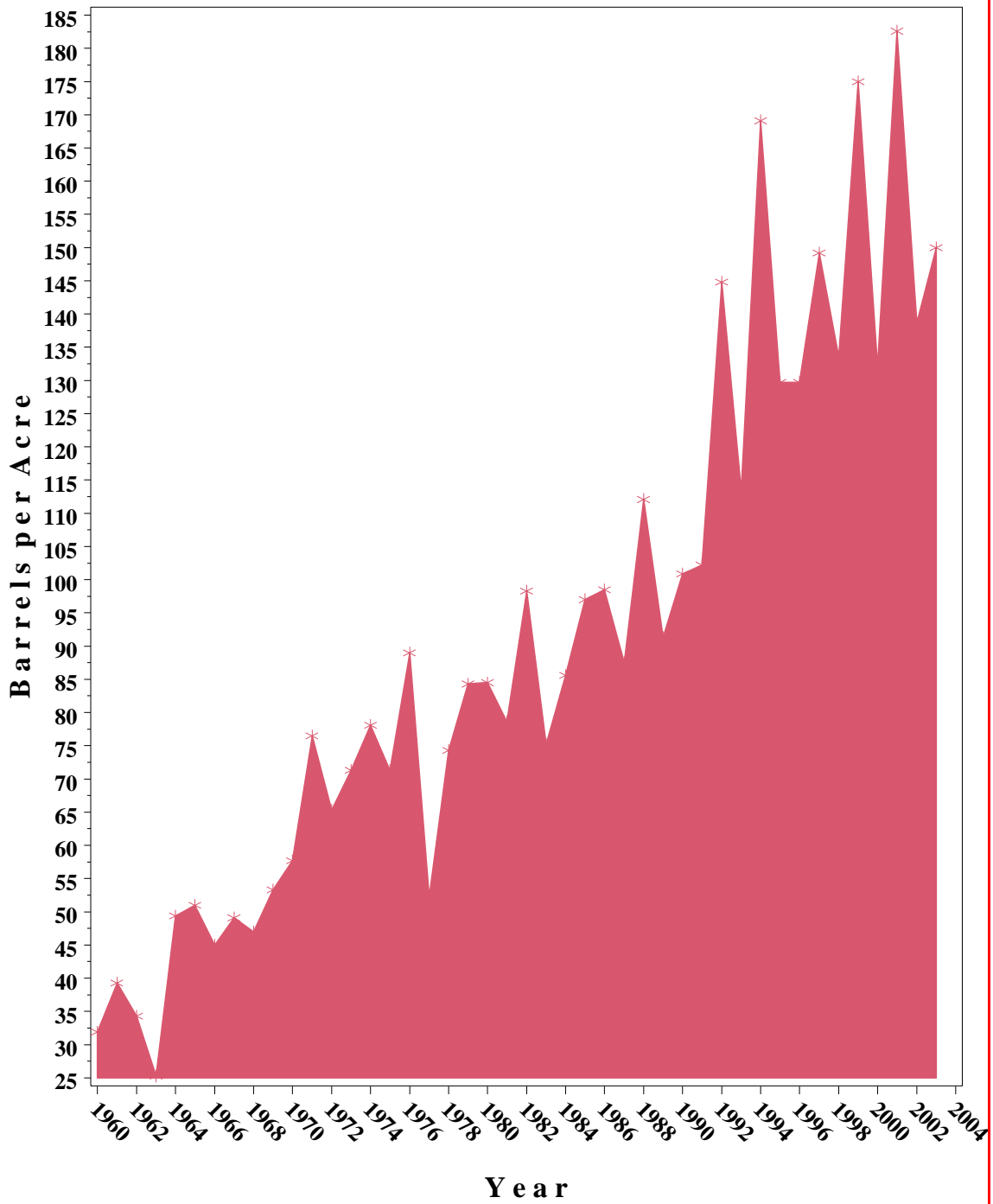

Massachusetts Cranberry Yield 1960 - 2003



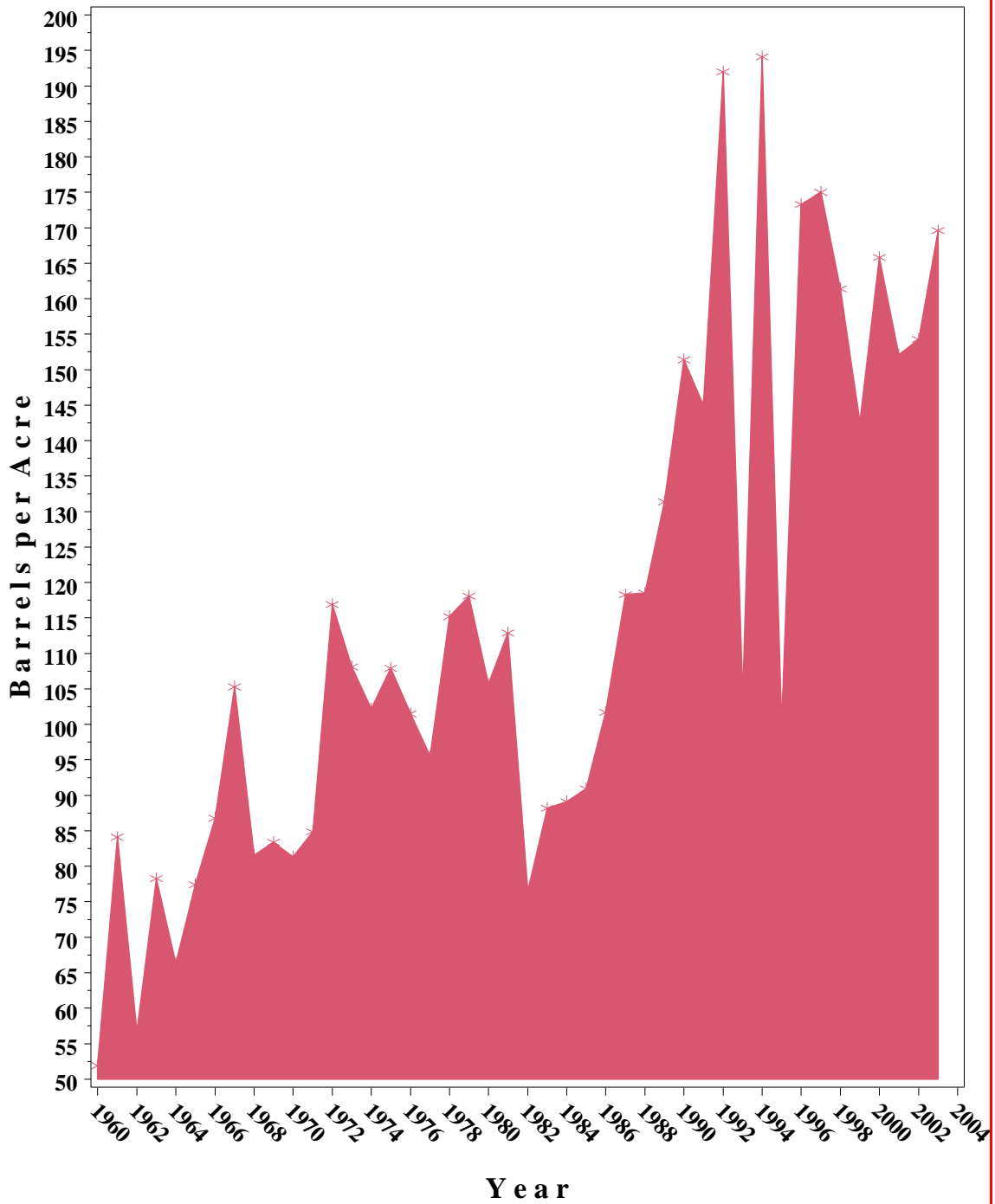

New Jersey Cranberry Yield 1960 - 2003



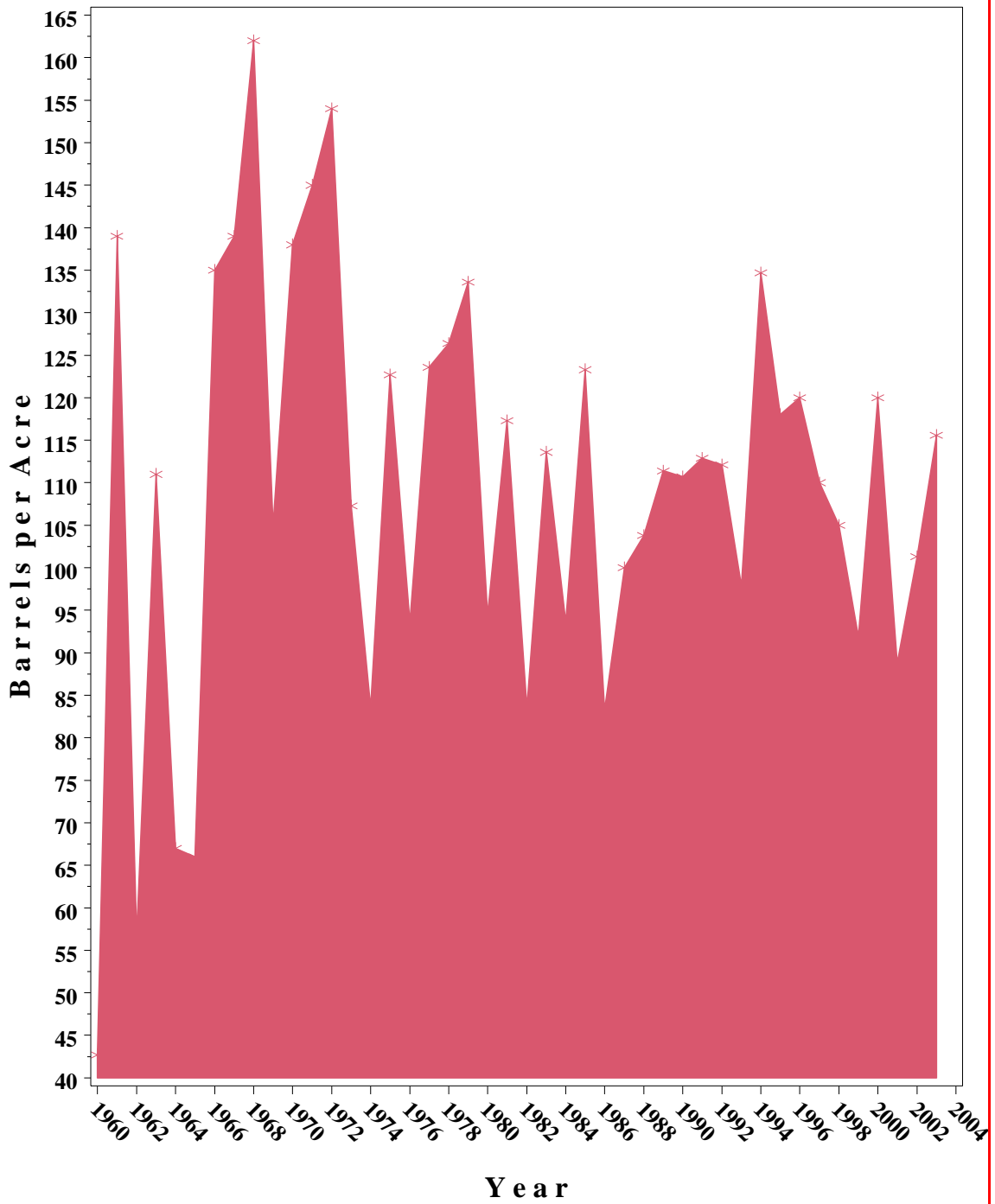

Oregon Cranberry Yield 1960 - 2003



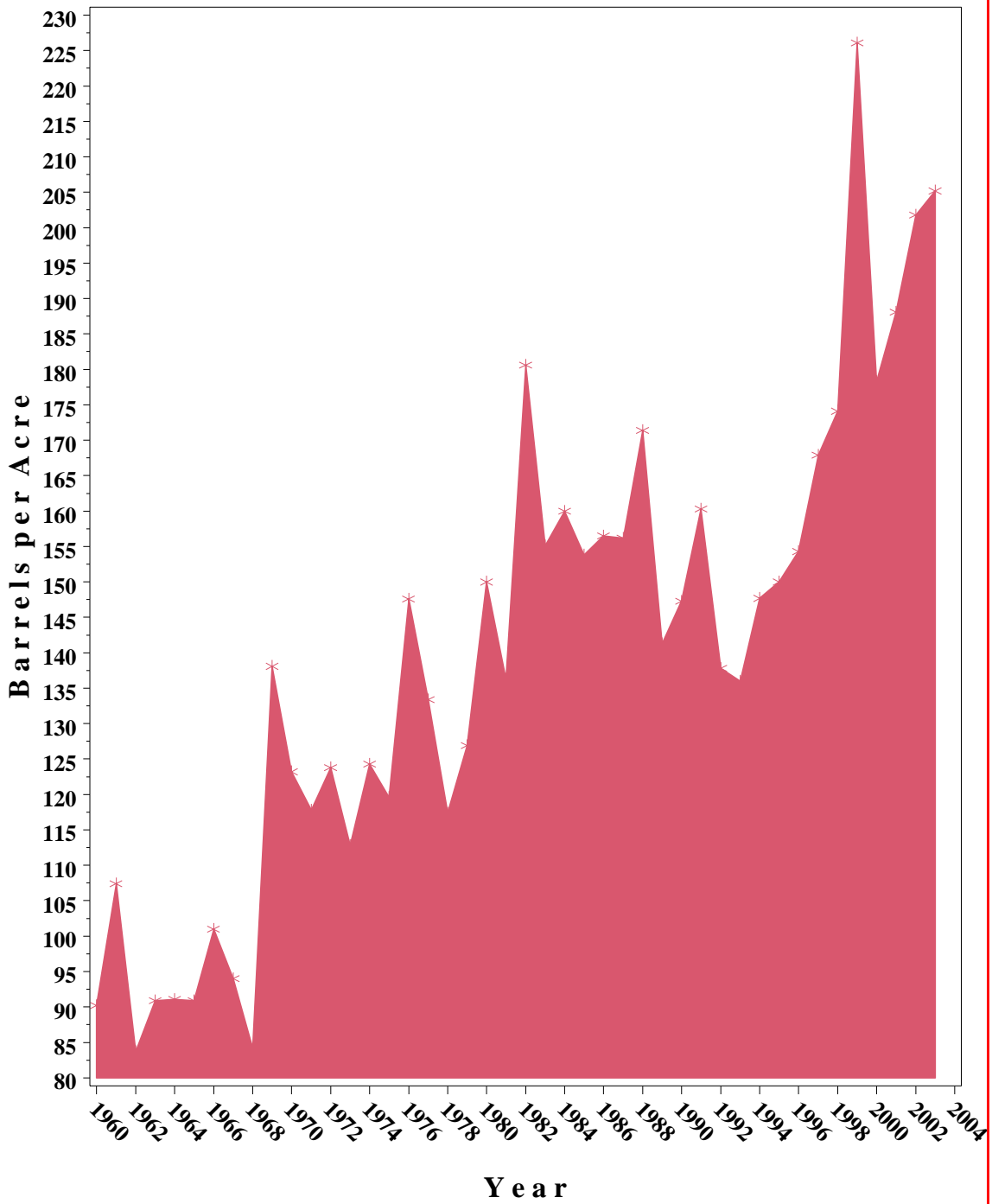

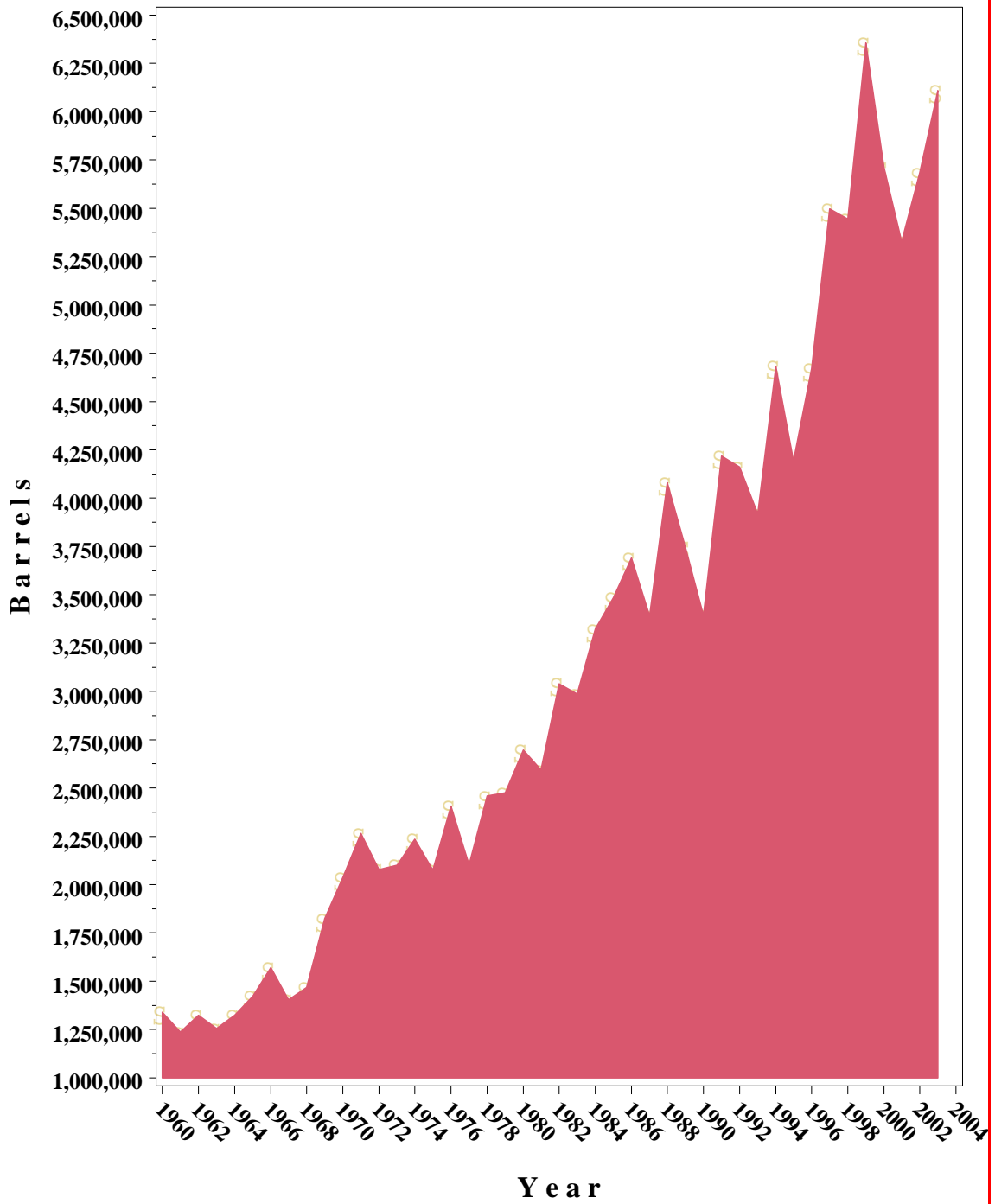

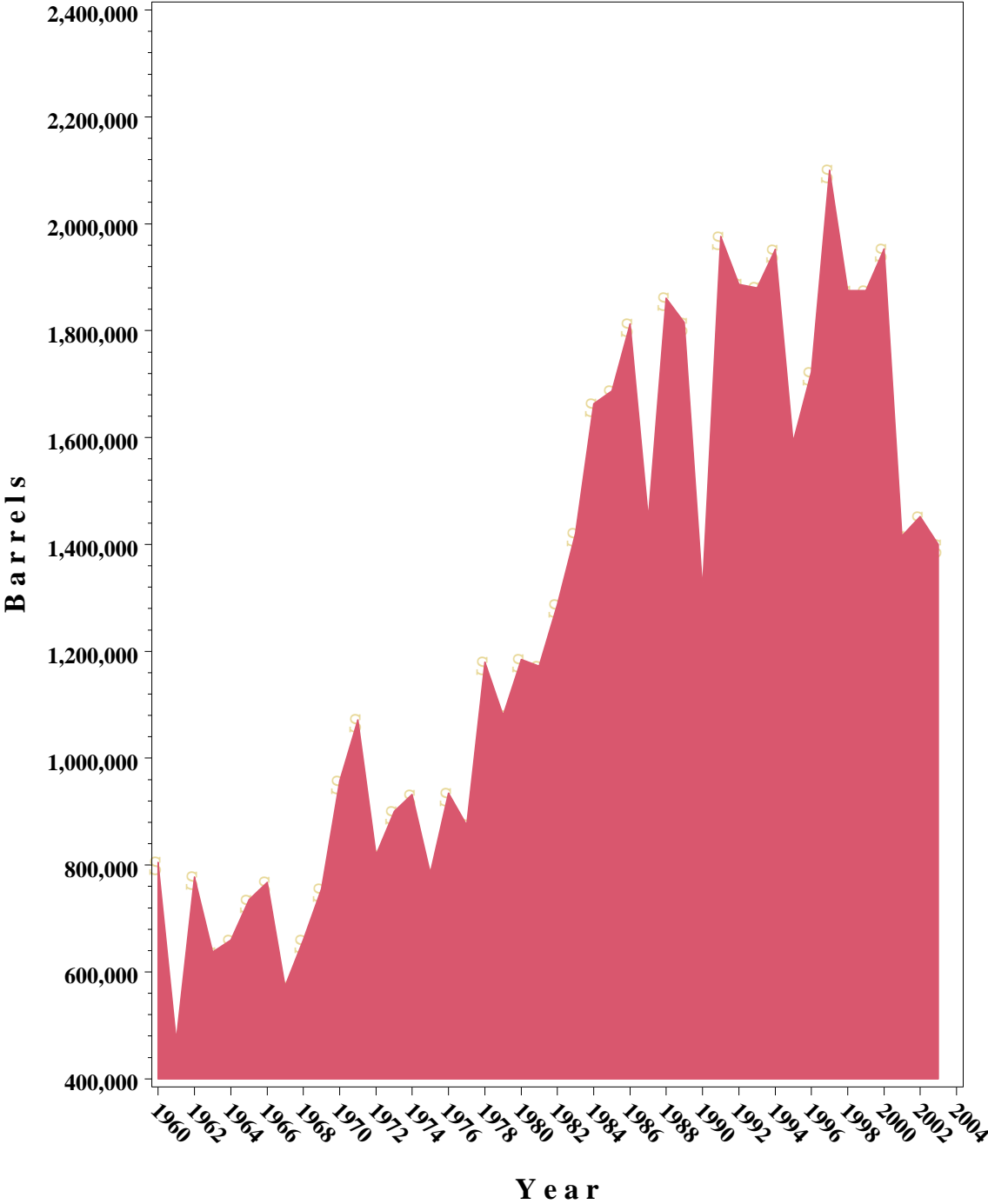

U.S. Cranberry Production 1960 - 2003



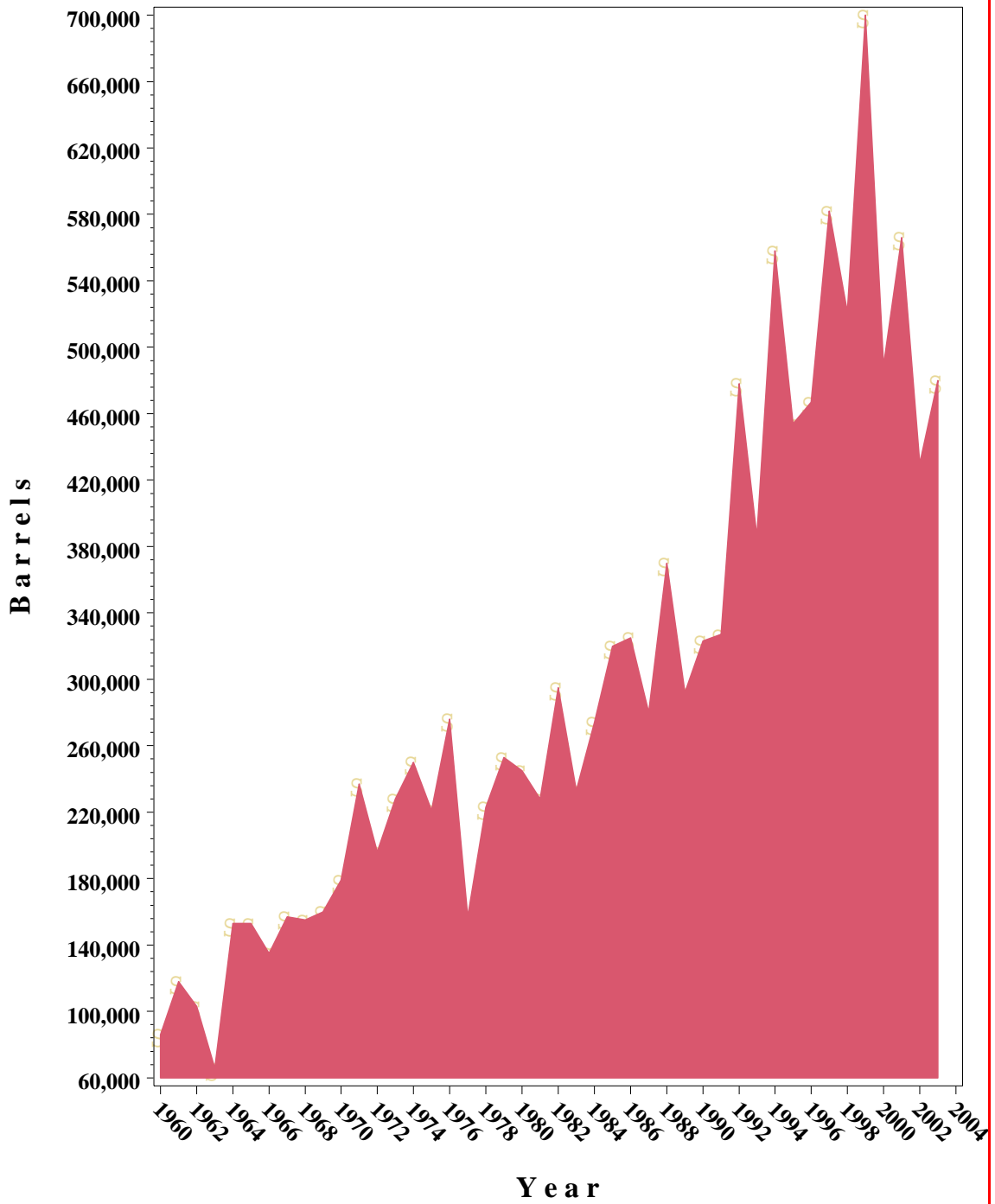

Massachusetts Cranberry Production 1960 - 2003



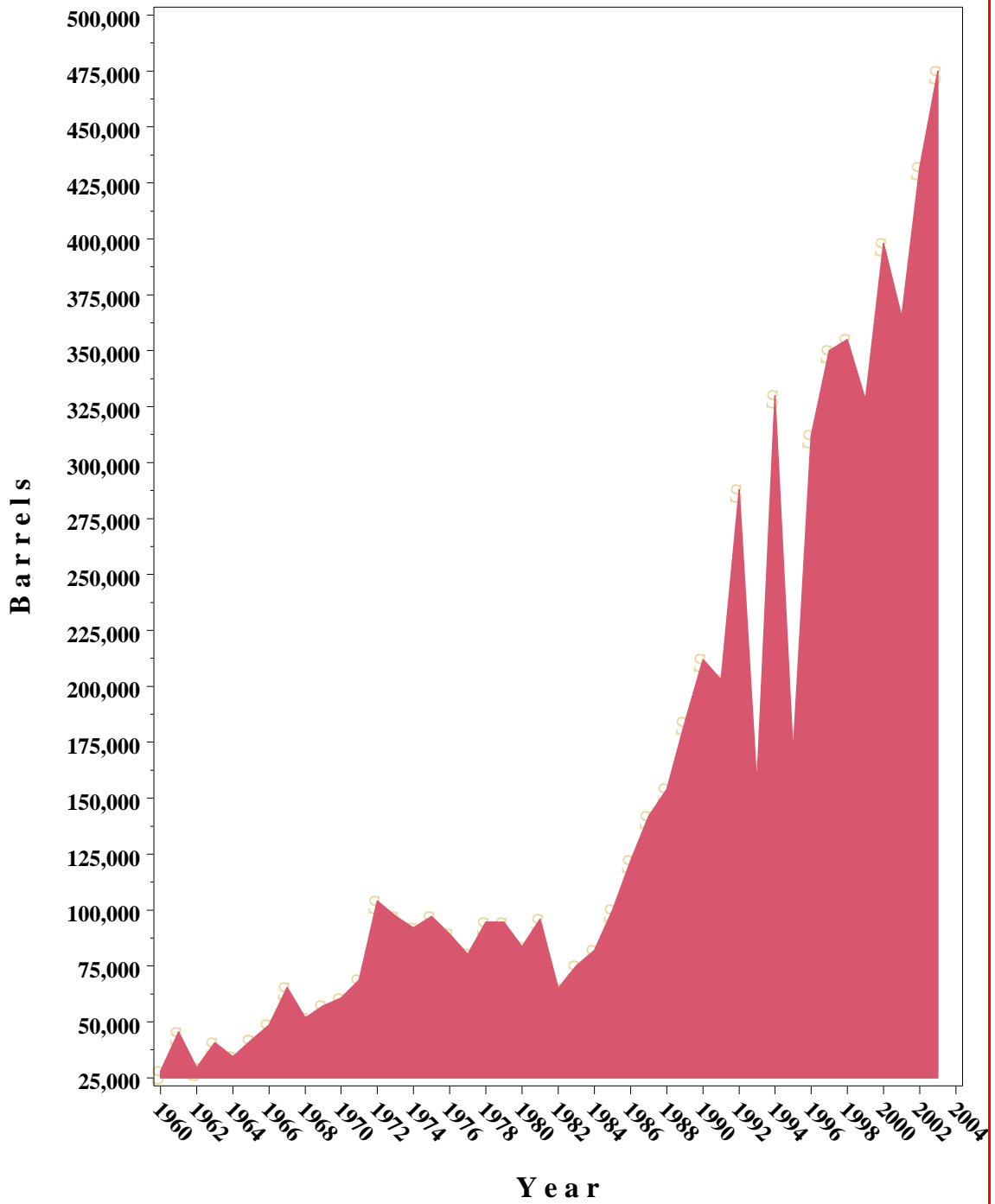

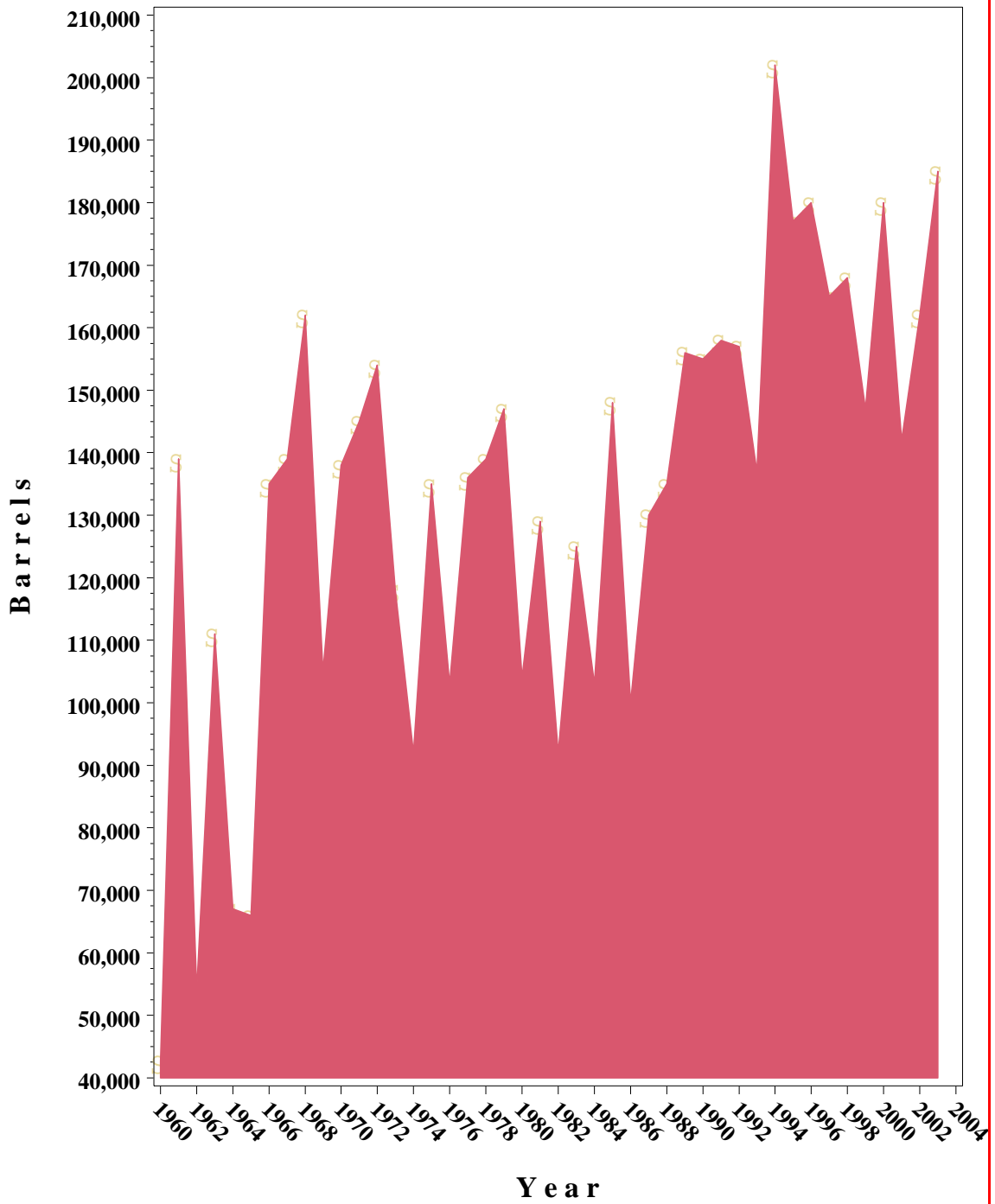

Oregon Cranberry Production 1960 - 2003



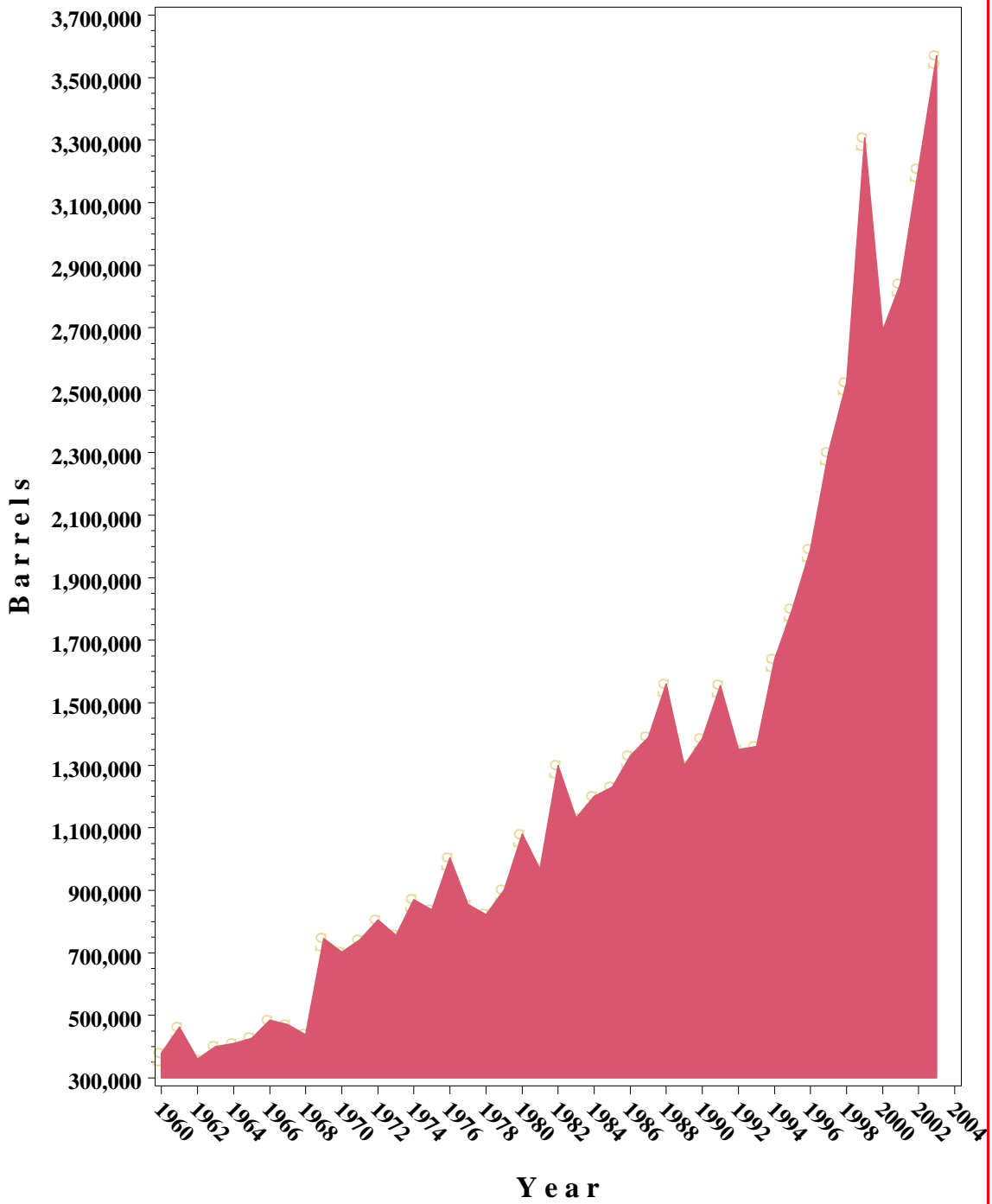

Washington Cranberry Production 1960 - 2003



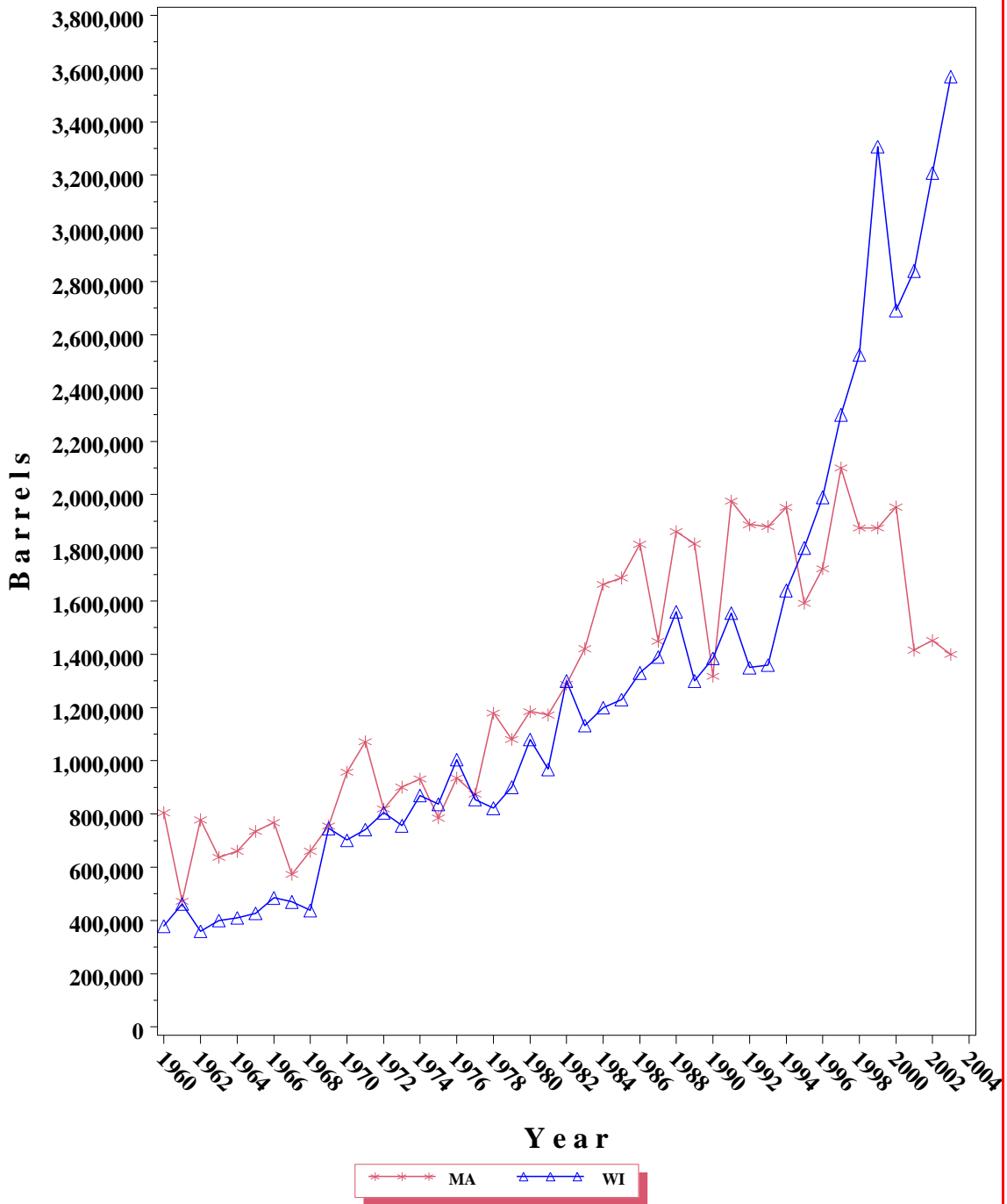

Wisconsin Cranberry Production 1960 - 2003



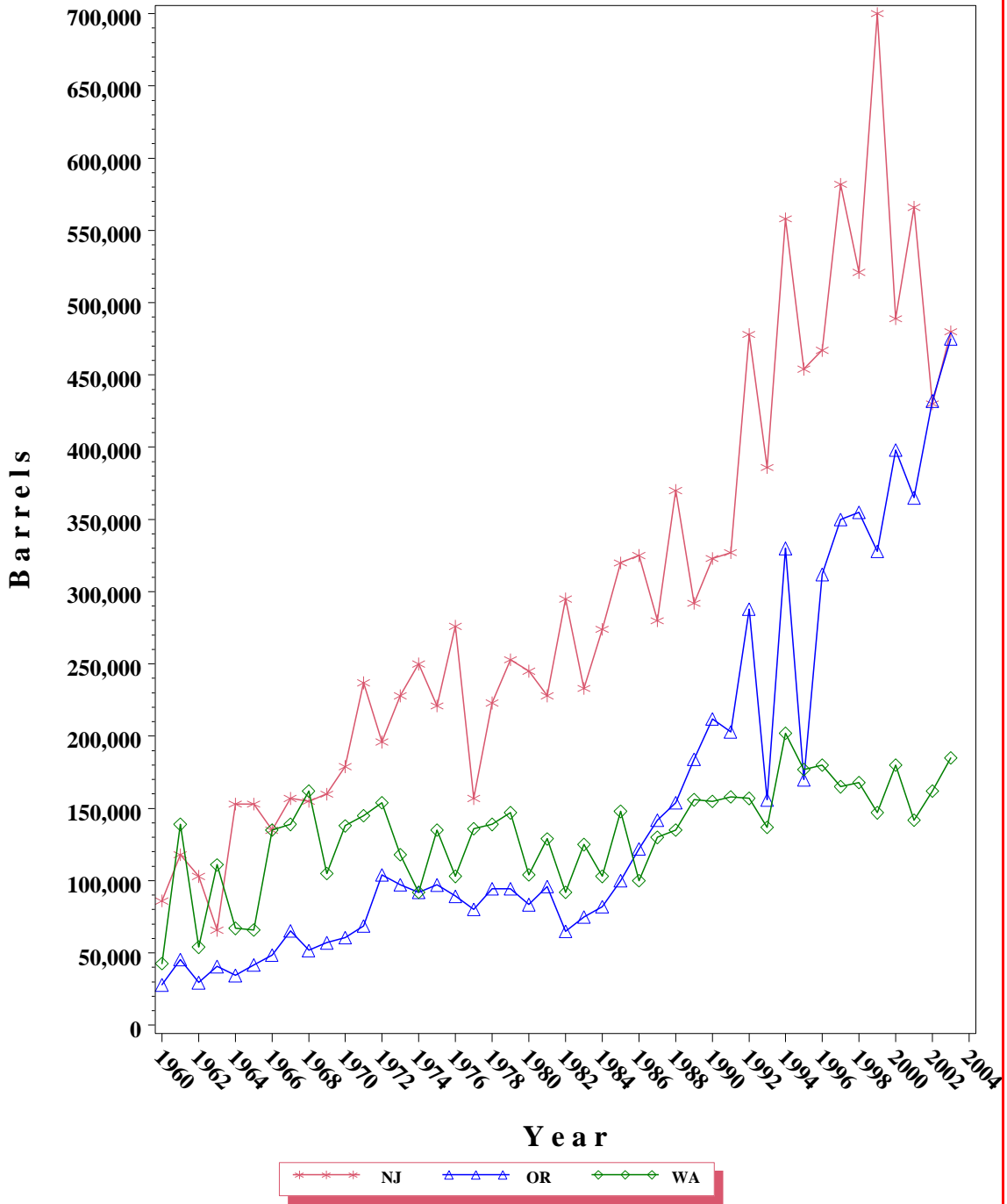

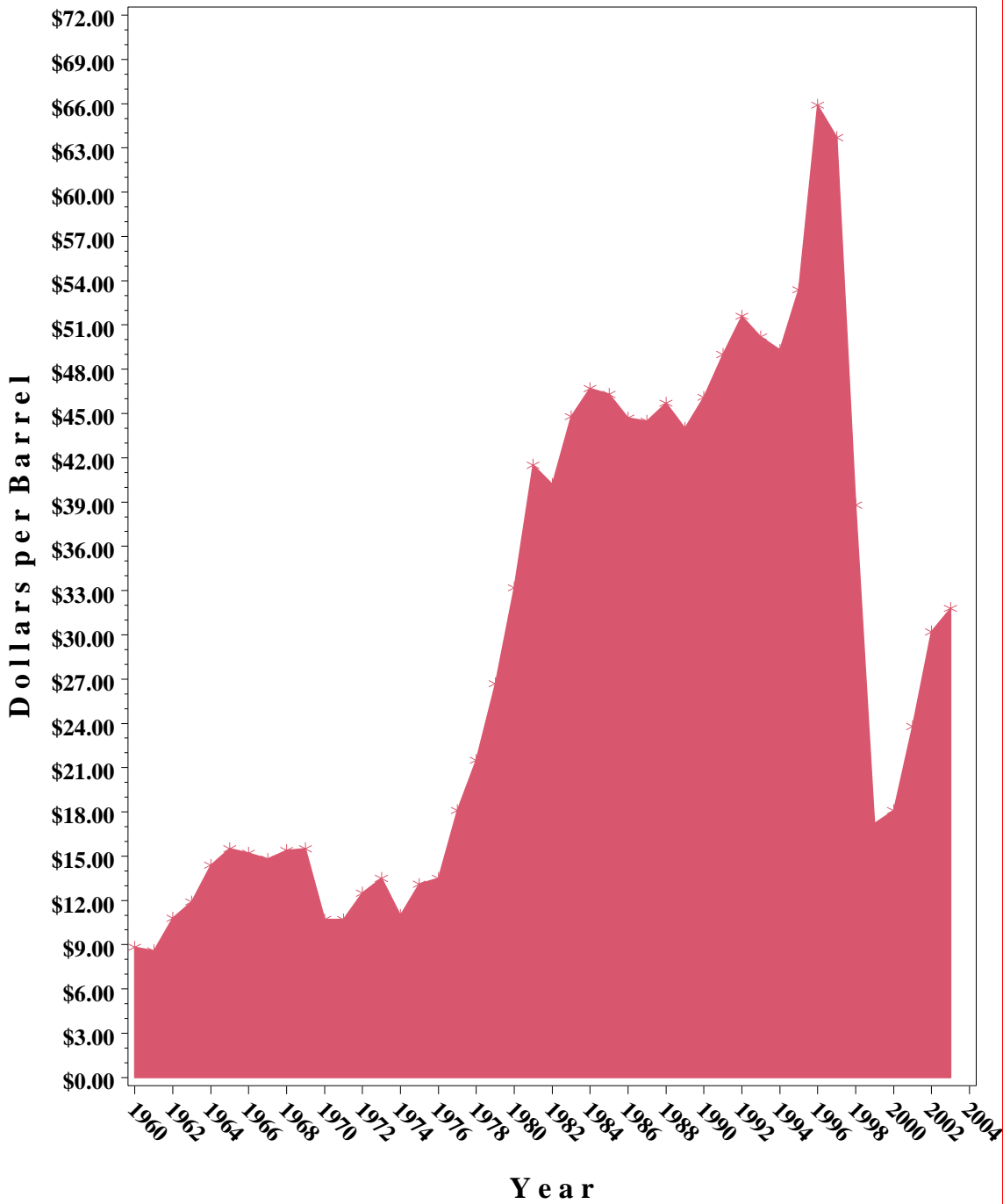

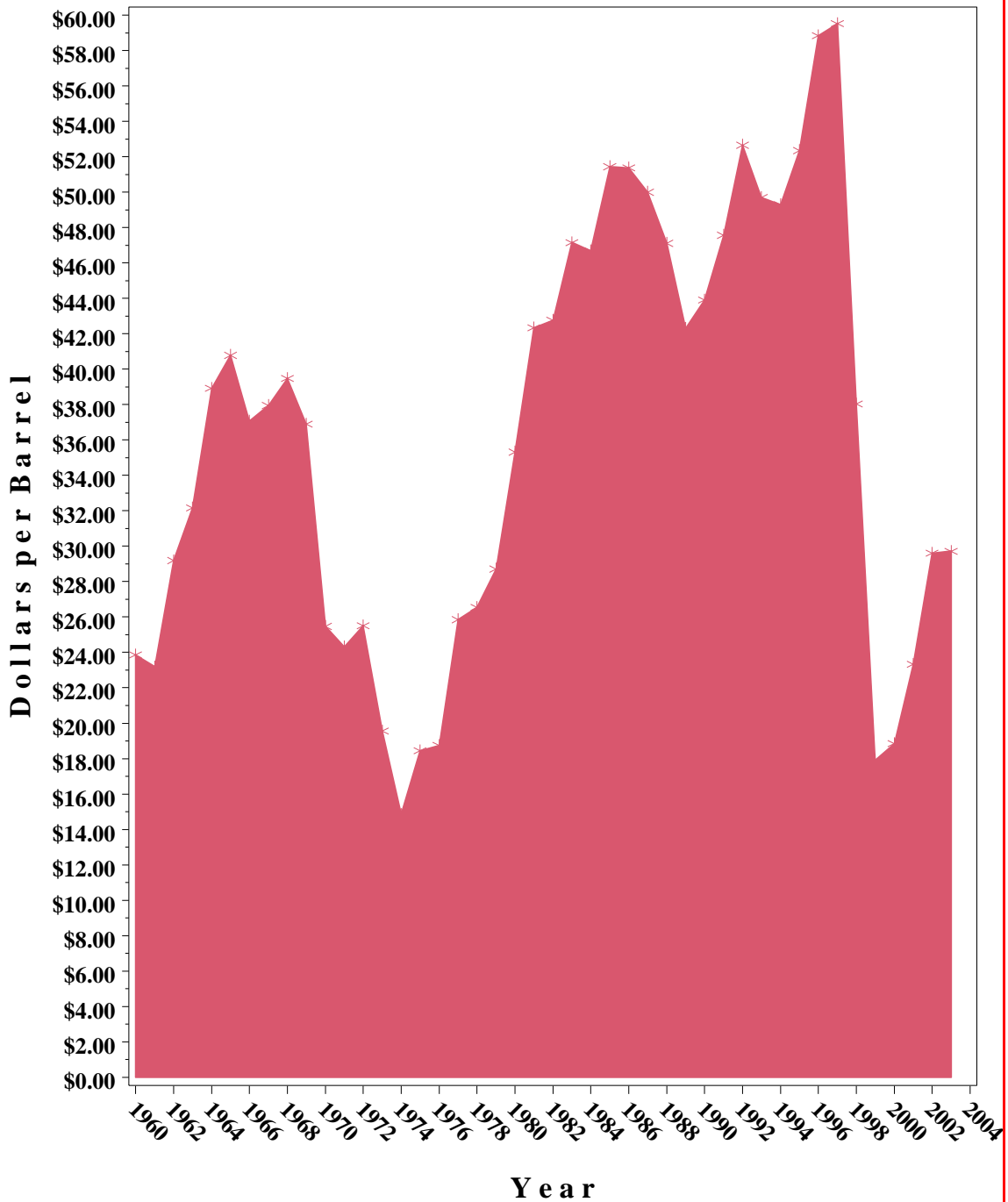

U.S. Cranberry Grower Prices 1960 - 2003



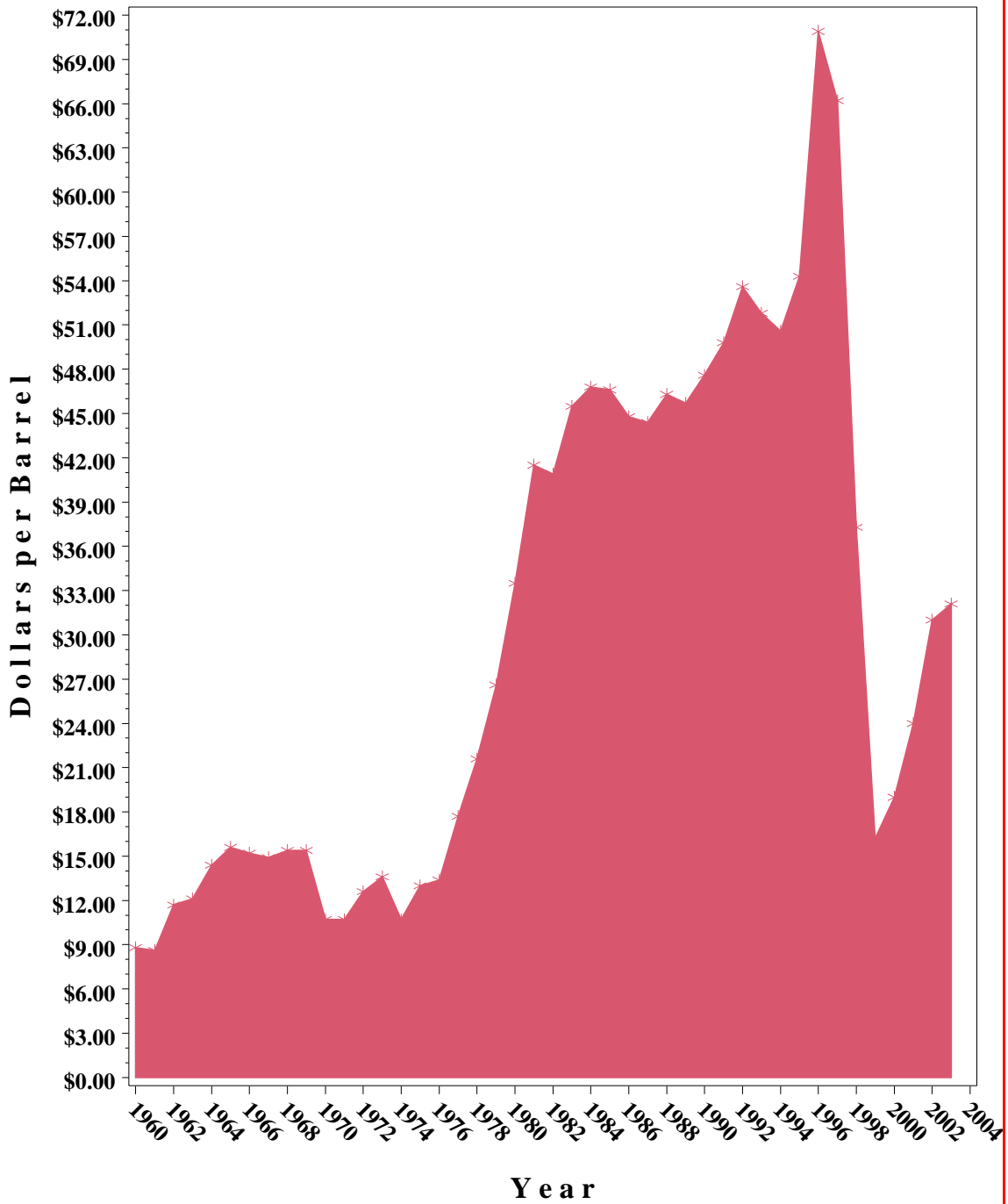

Real U.S. Cranberry Grower Prices 1960 - 2003



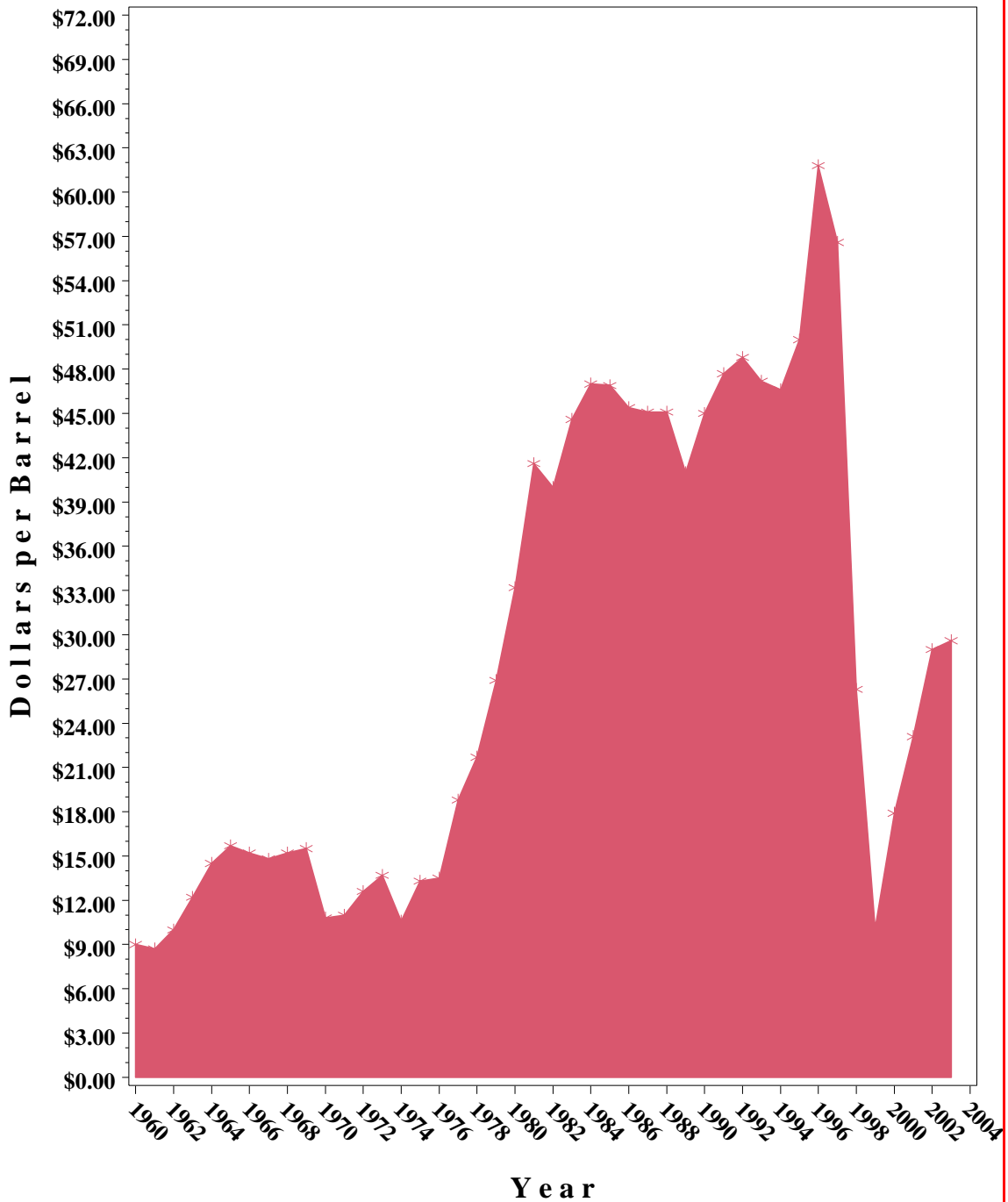

Massachusetts Cranberry Grower Prices 1960 - 2003



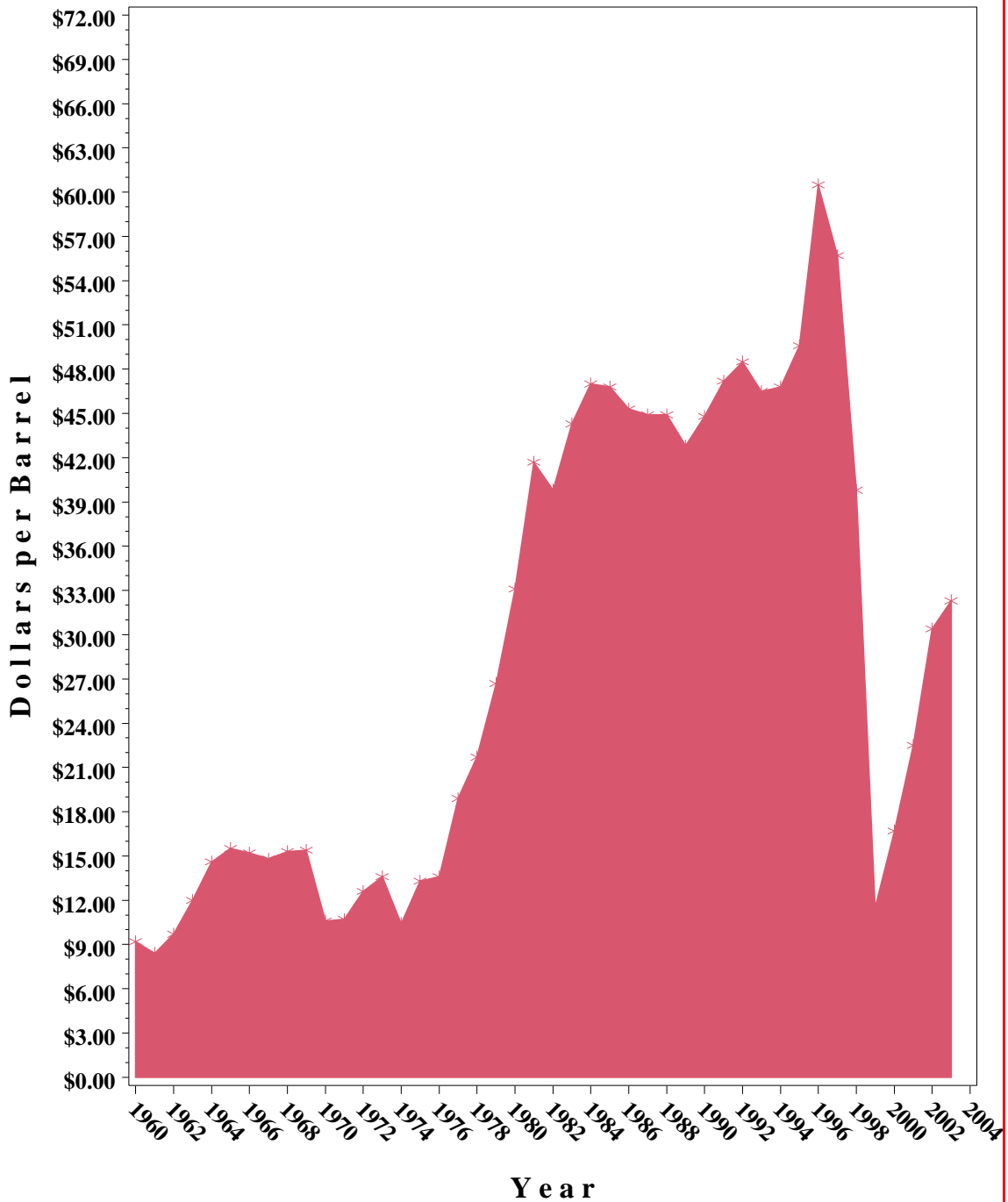

New Jersey Cranberry Grower Prices 1960 - 2003



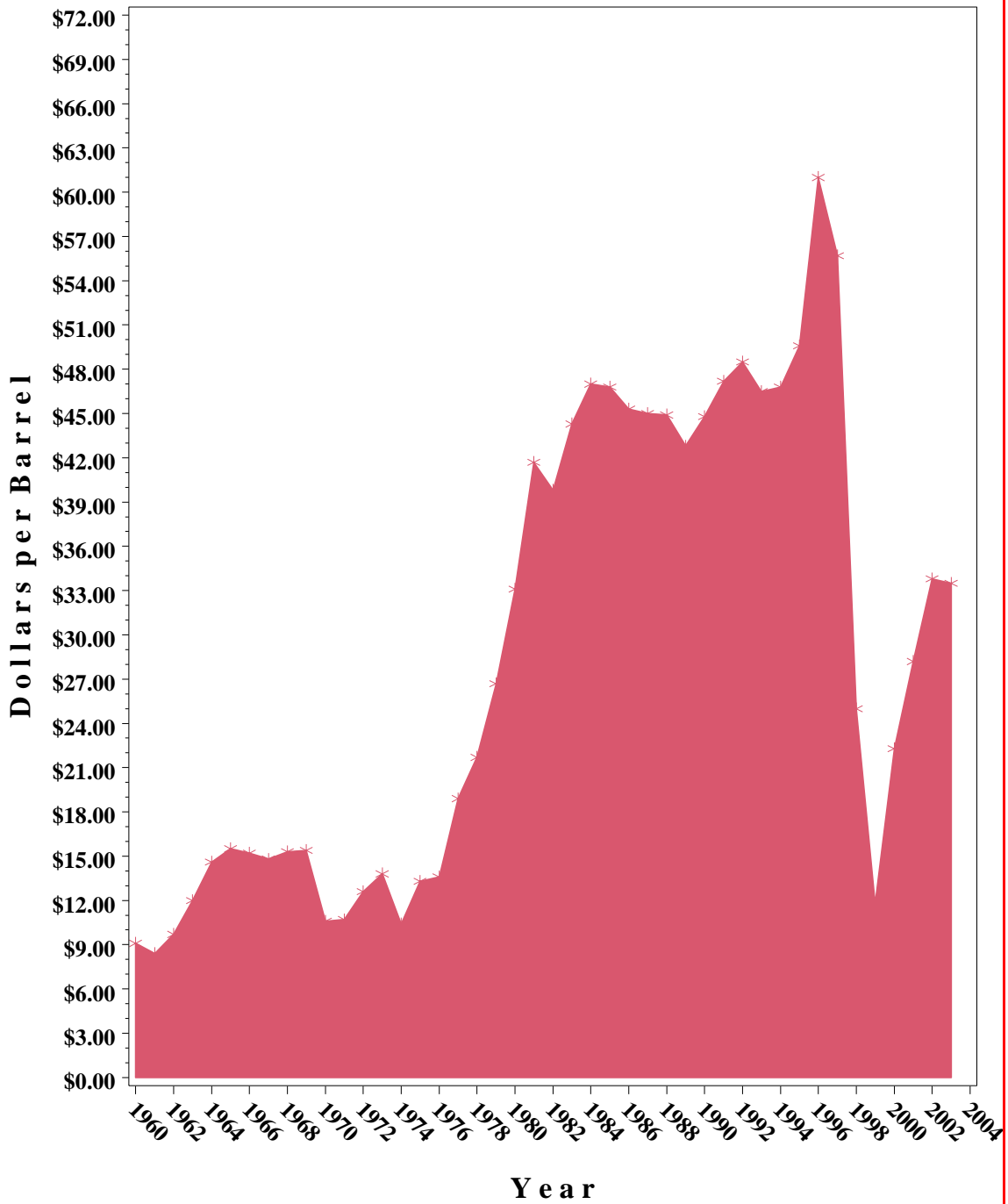

Oregon Cranberry Grower Prices 1960 - 2003



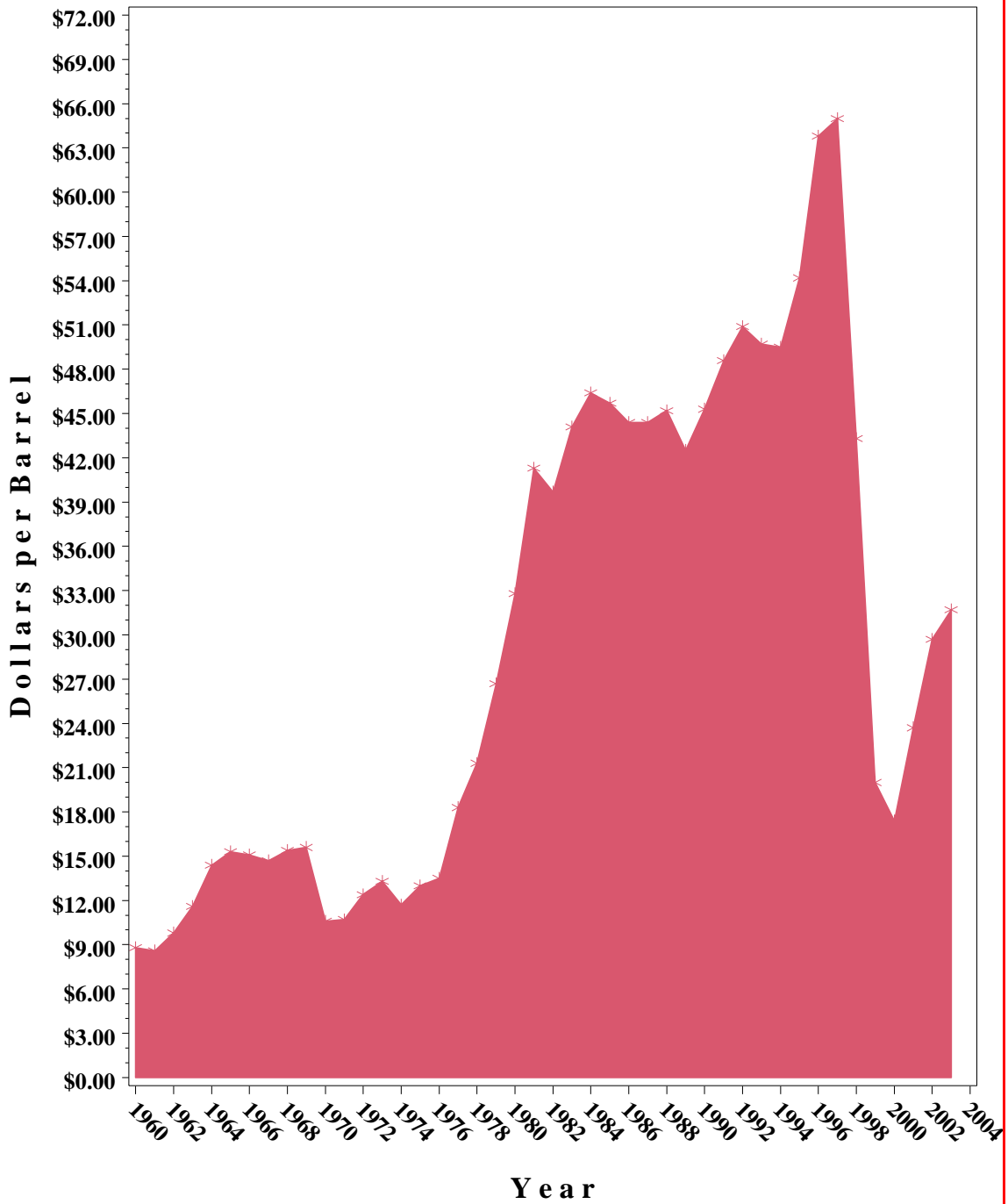

Wisconsin Cranberry Grower Prices 1960 - 2003



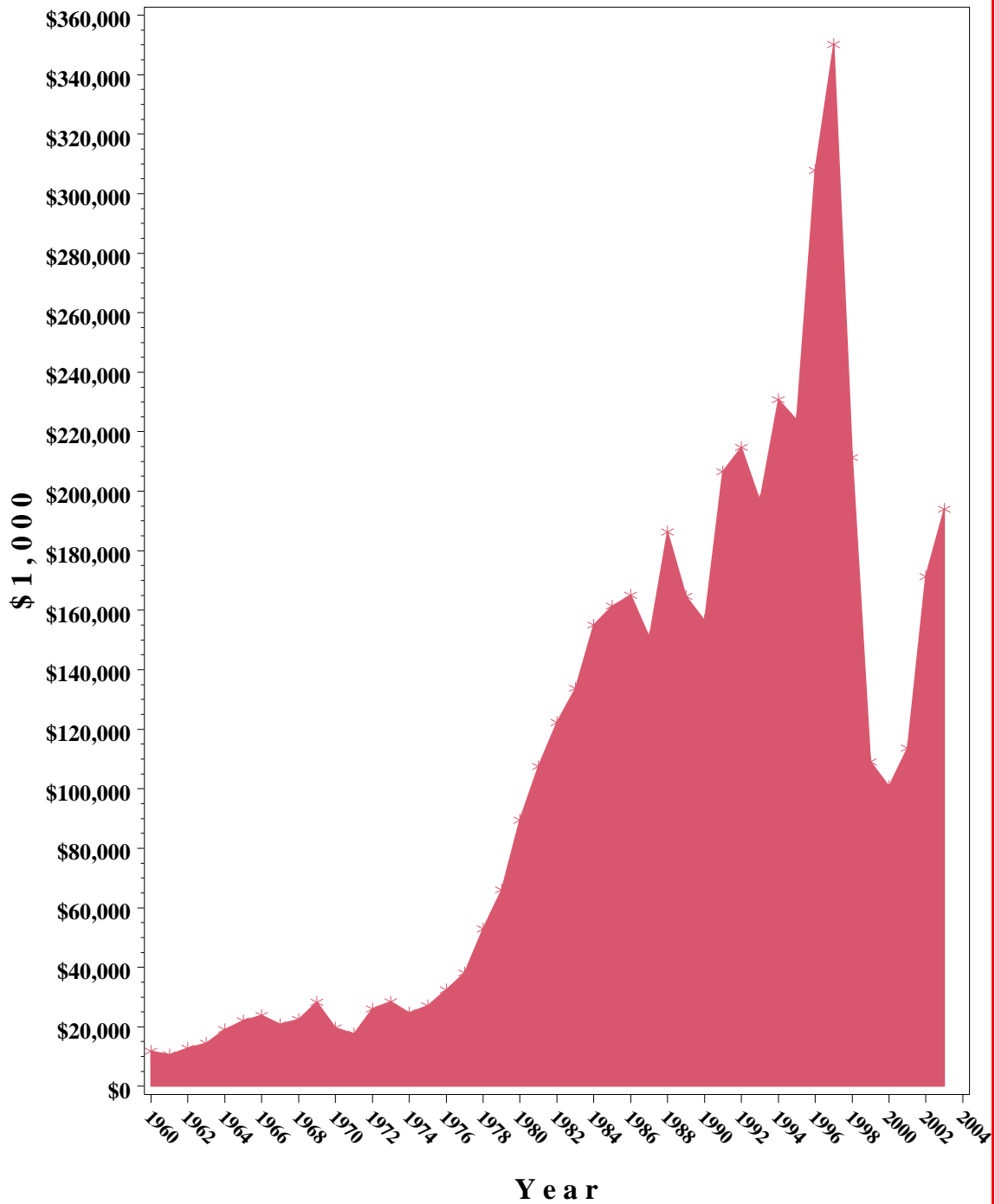

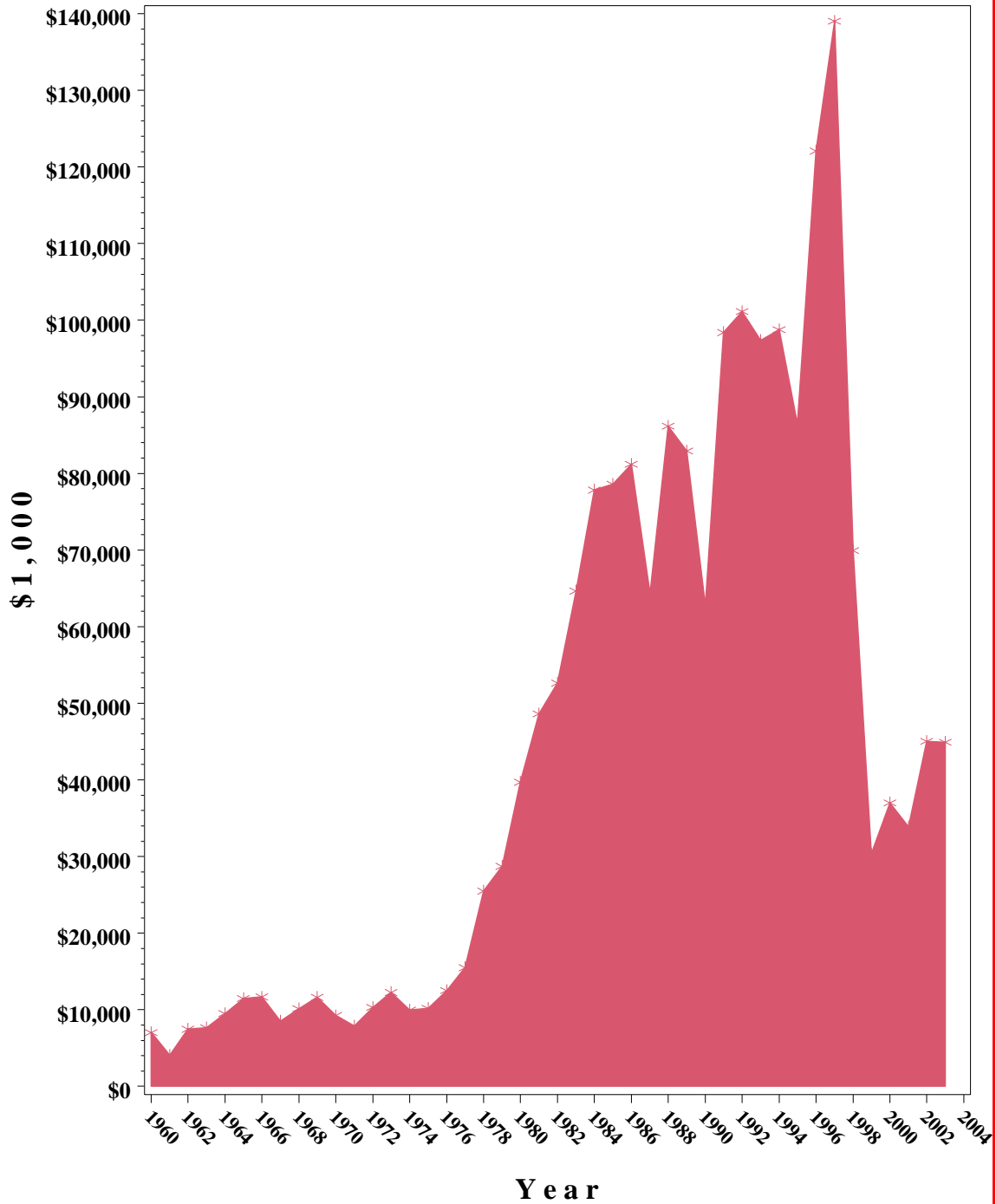

U.S. Cranberry Farm Value of Utilized Production 1960 - 2003



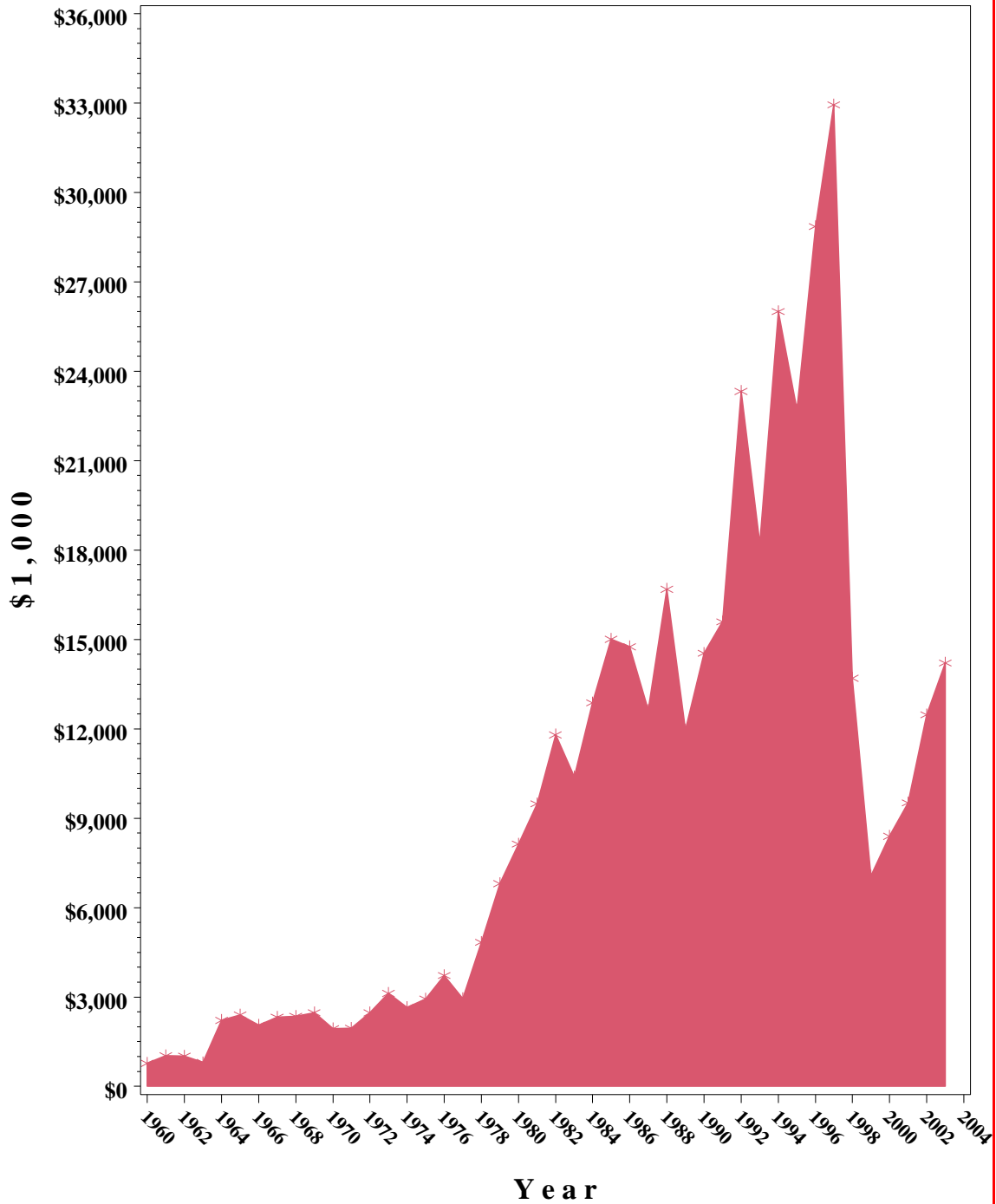

Massachusetts Cranberry Farm Value of Utilized Production 1960 - 2003



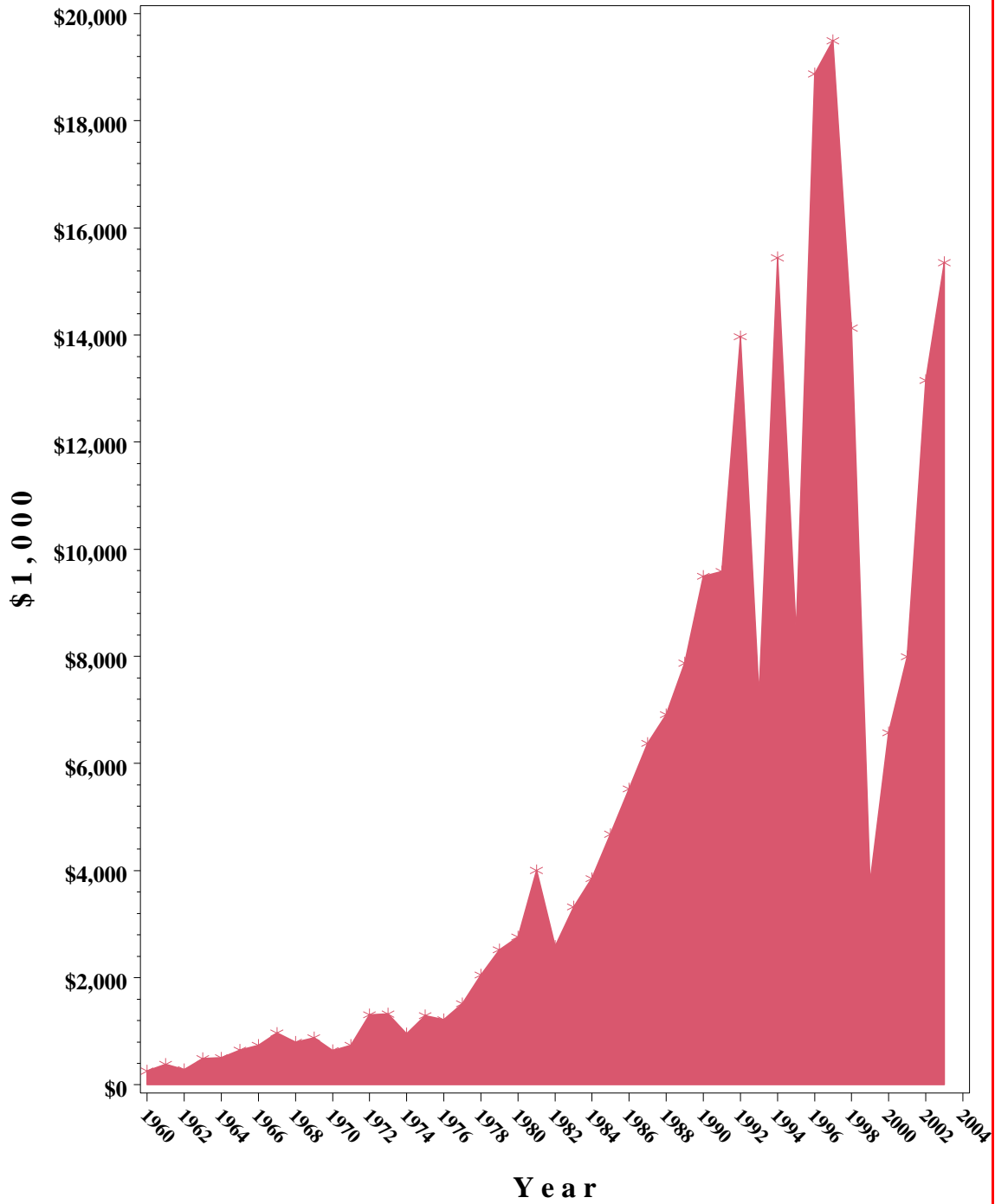

New Jersey Cranberry Farm Value of Utilized Production 1960 - 2003



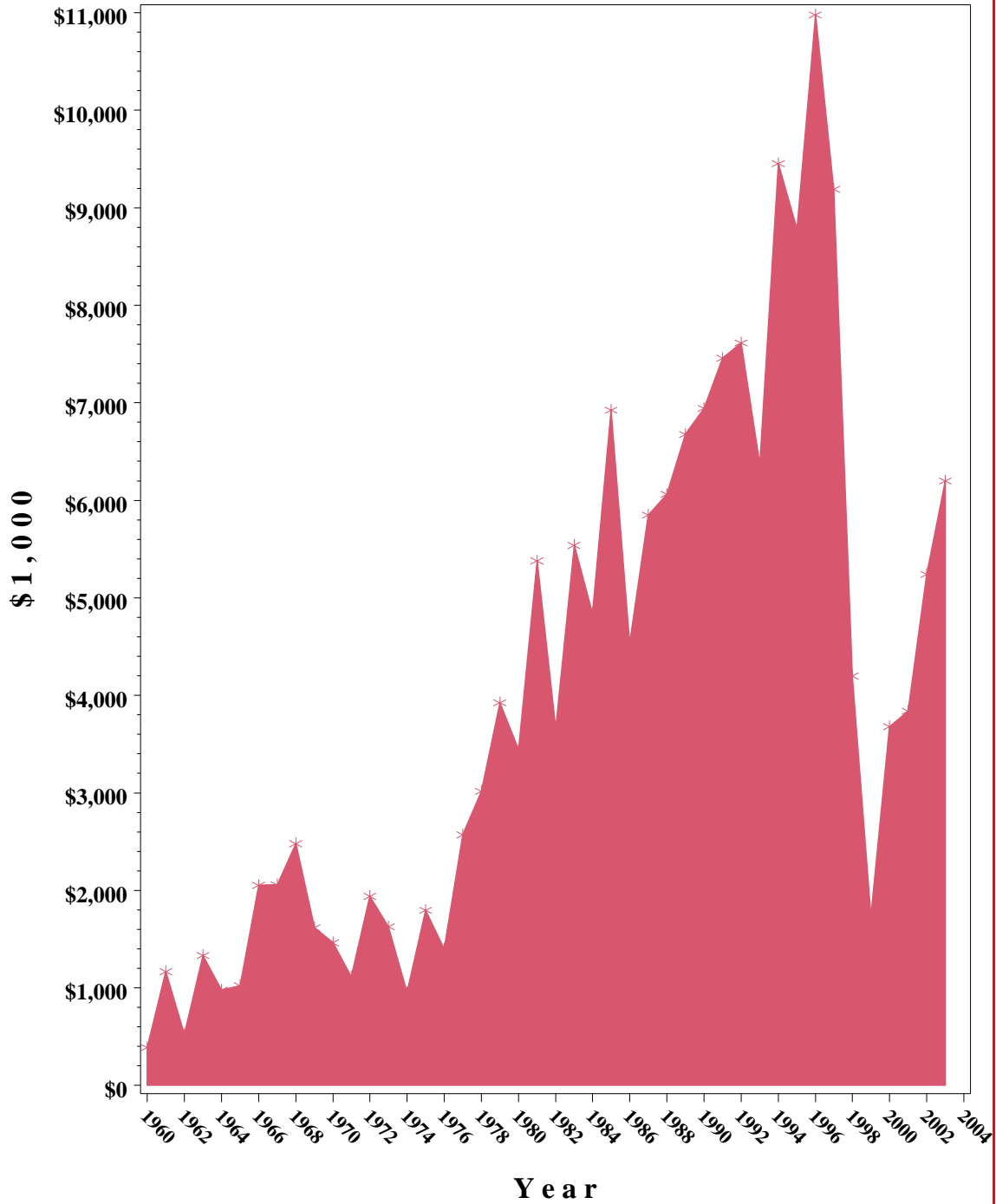

Oregon Cranberry Farm Value of Utilized Production 1960 - 2003



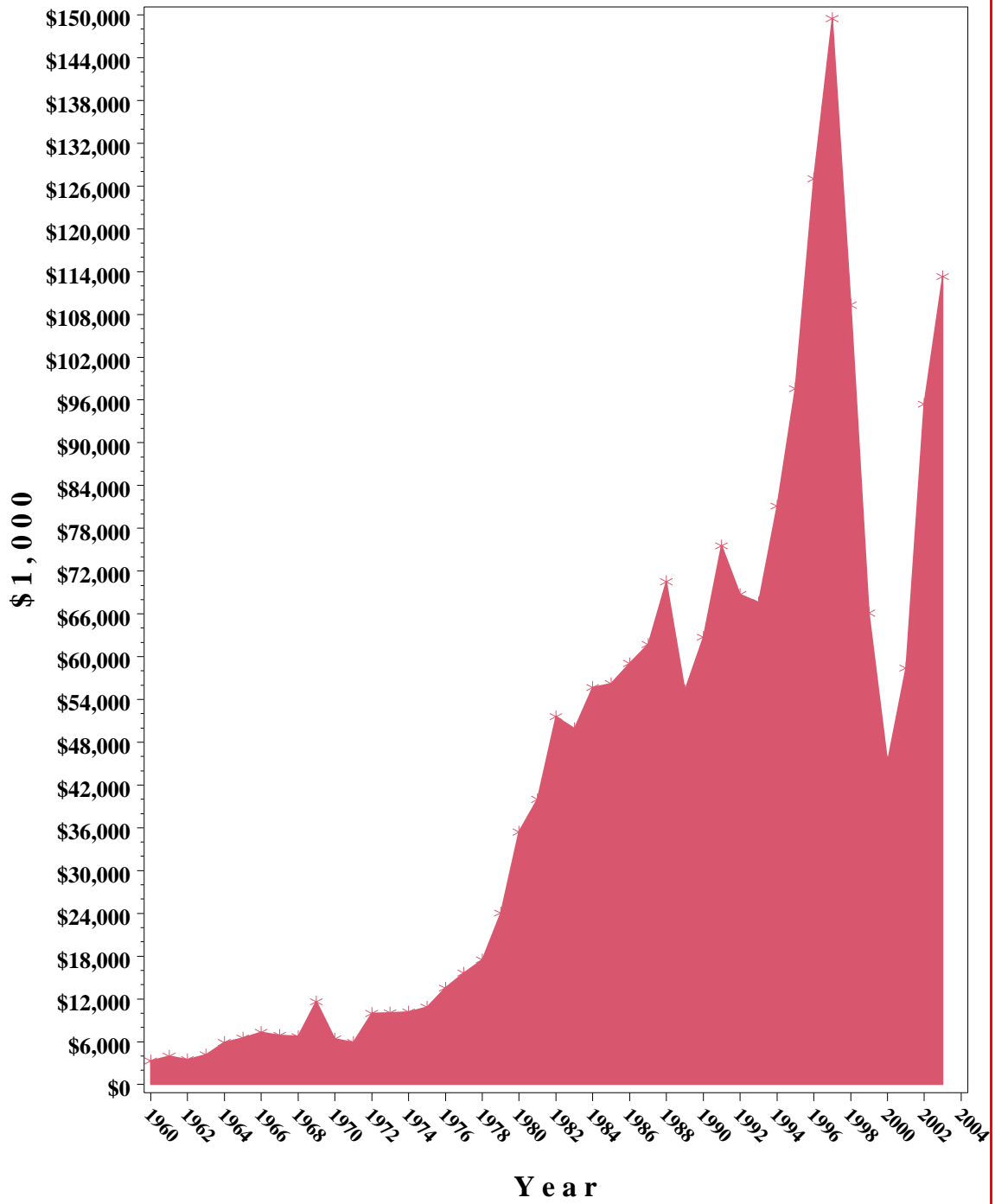

Washington Cranberry Farm Value of Utilized Production 1960 - 2003



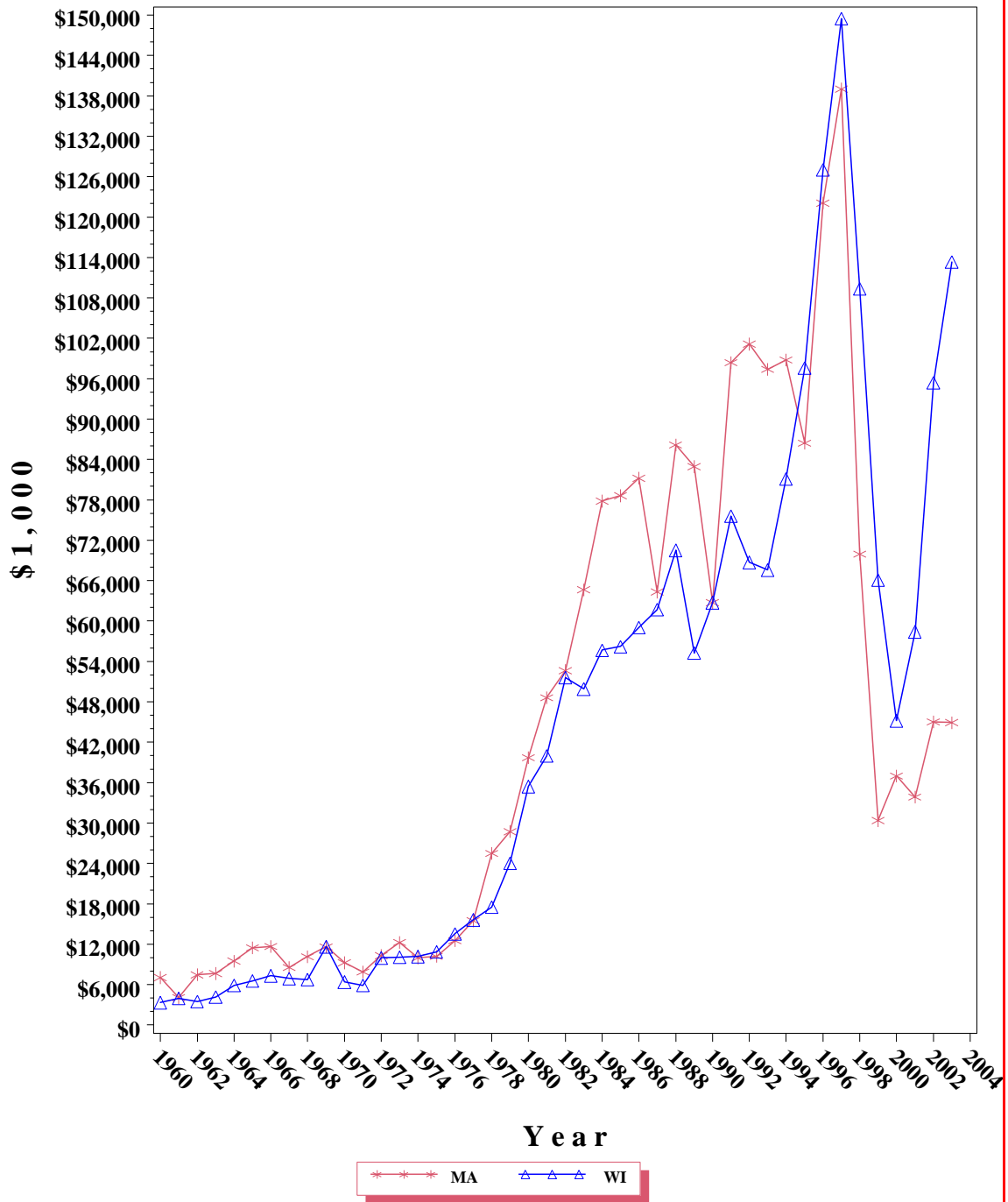

Wisconsin Cranberry Farm Value of Utilized Production 1960 - 2003



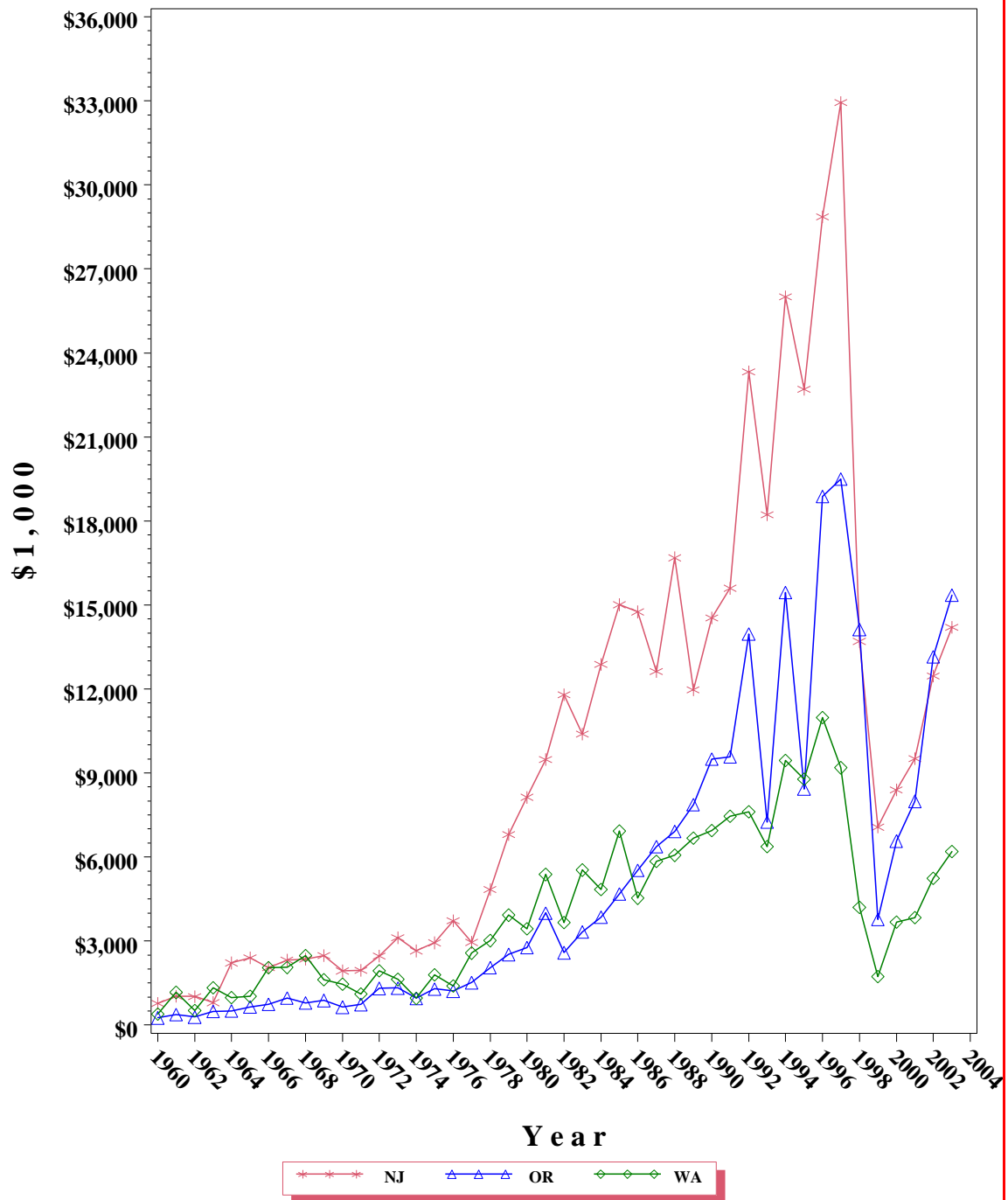

Massachusetts and Wisconsin Cranberry Value of Utilized Production 1960 - 2003



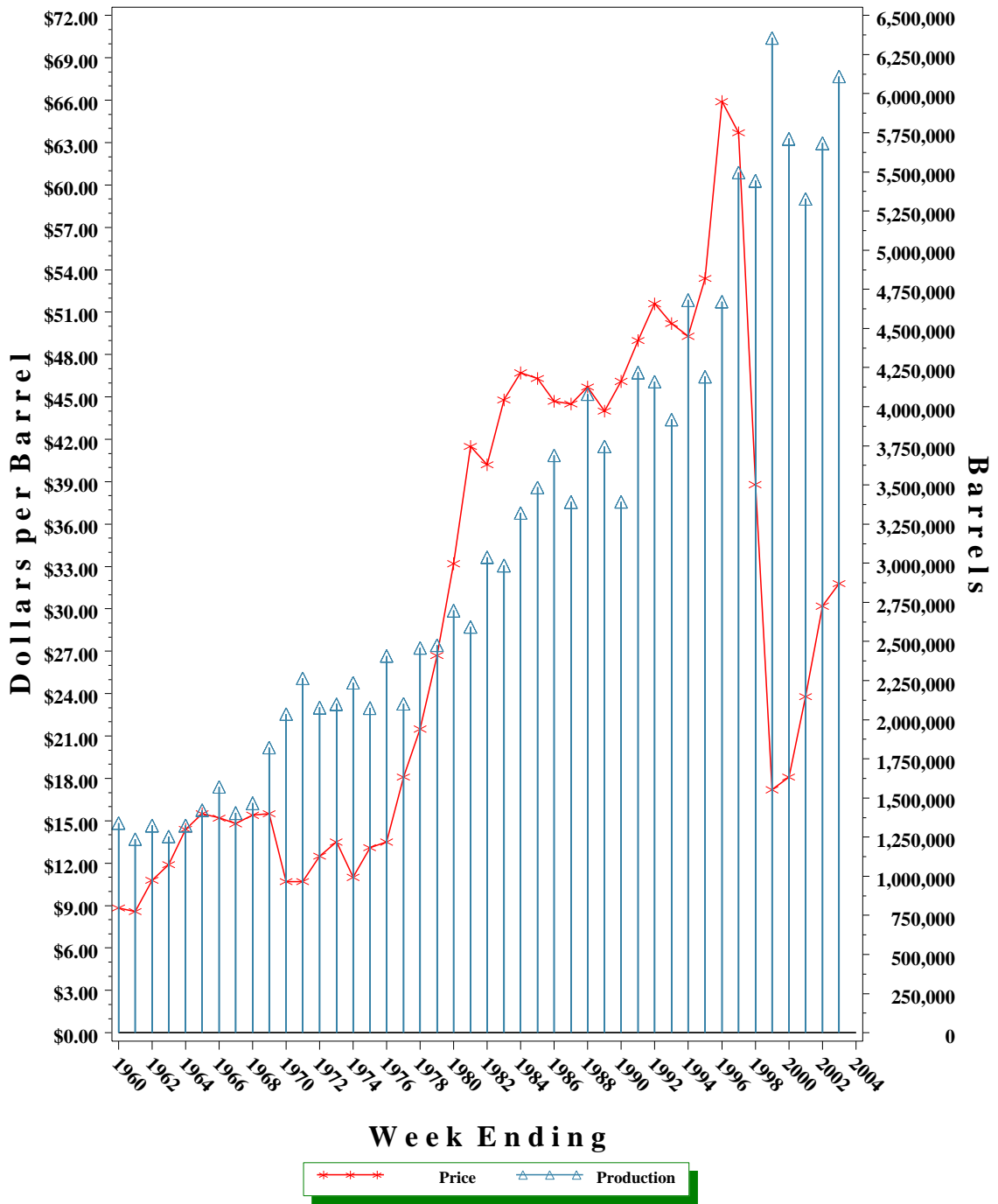

New Jersey, Oregon, and Washington Cranberry Value of Utilized Production 1960 - 2003

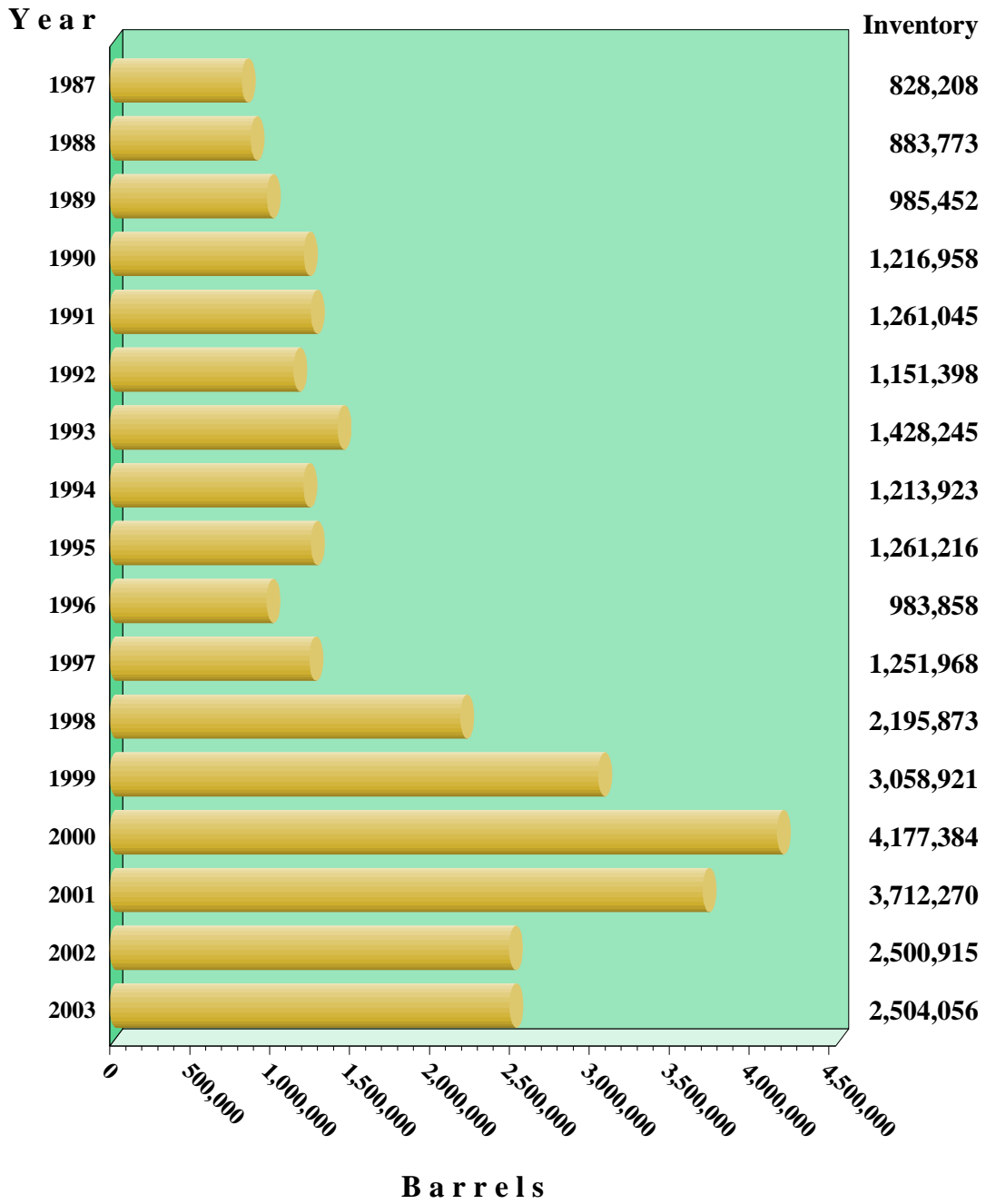

Comparison of Cranberry Production and Grower Prices 1960 - 2003

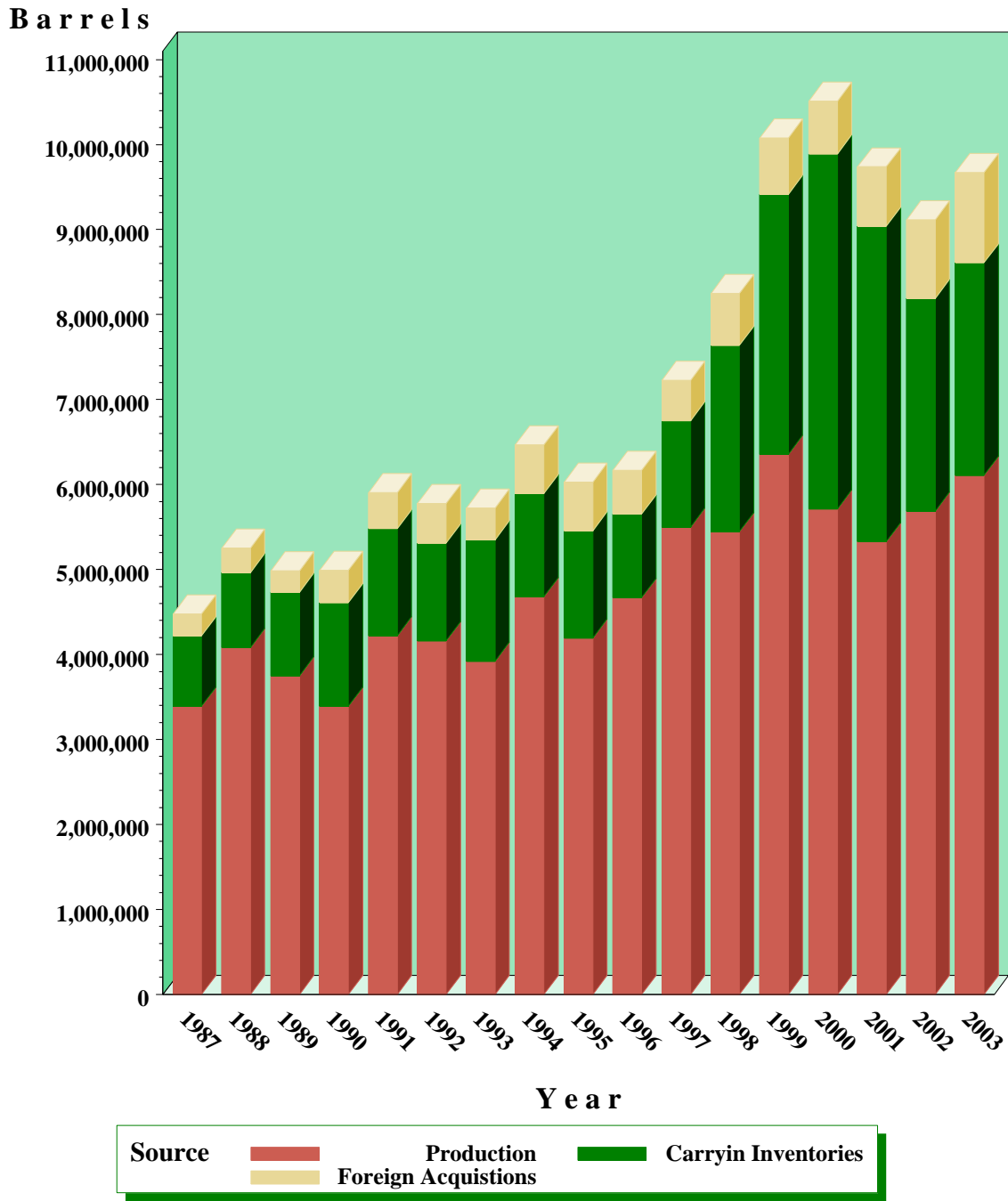


Cranberry Handler Carryin Inventories 1987 - 2003



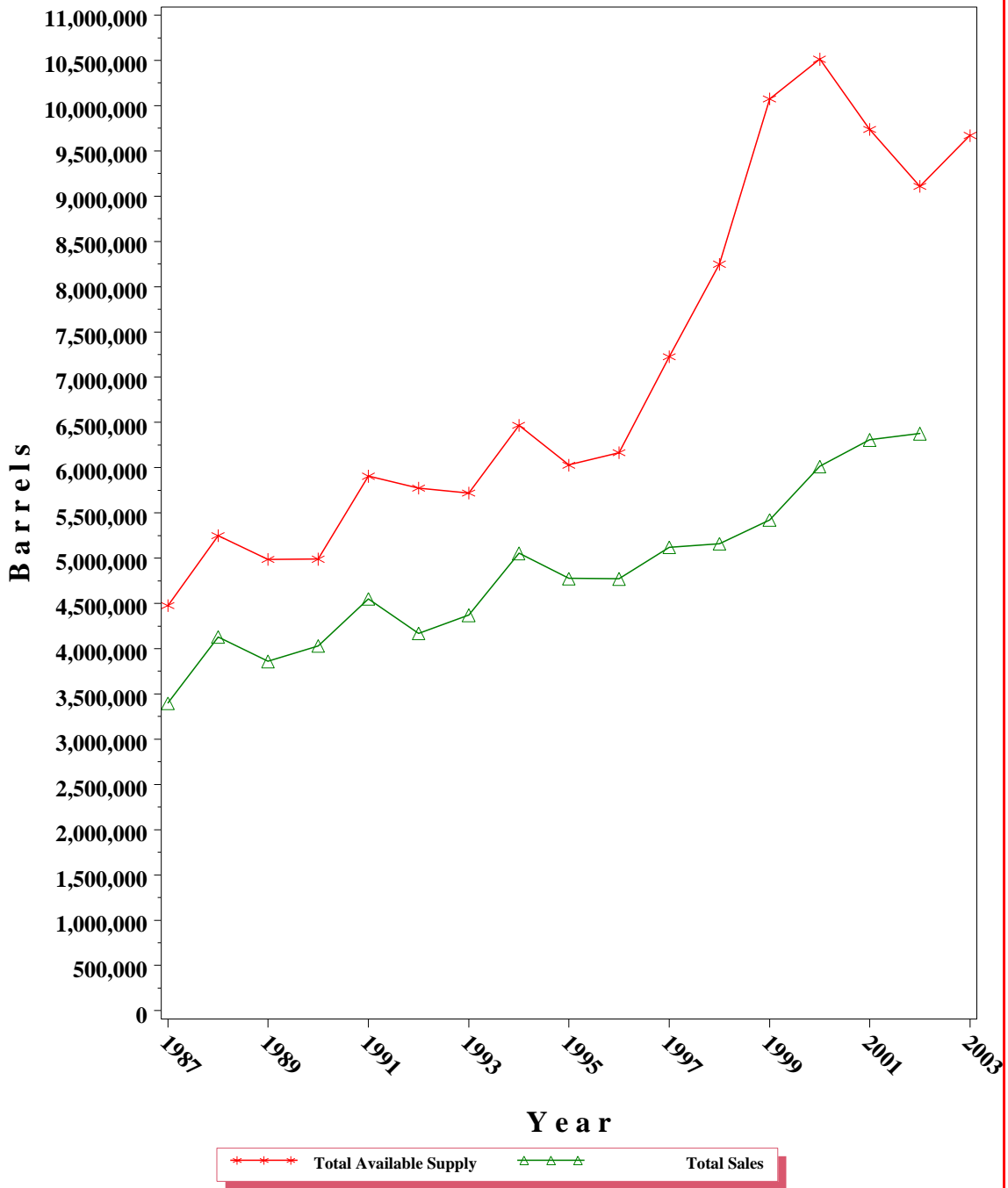

Cranberry Total Available Supply 1987 - 2003



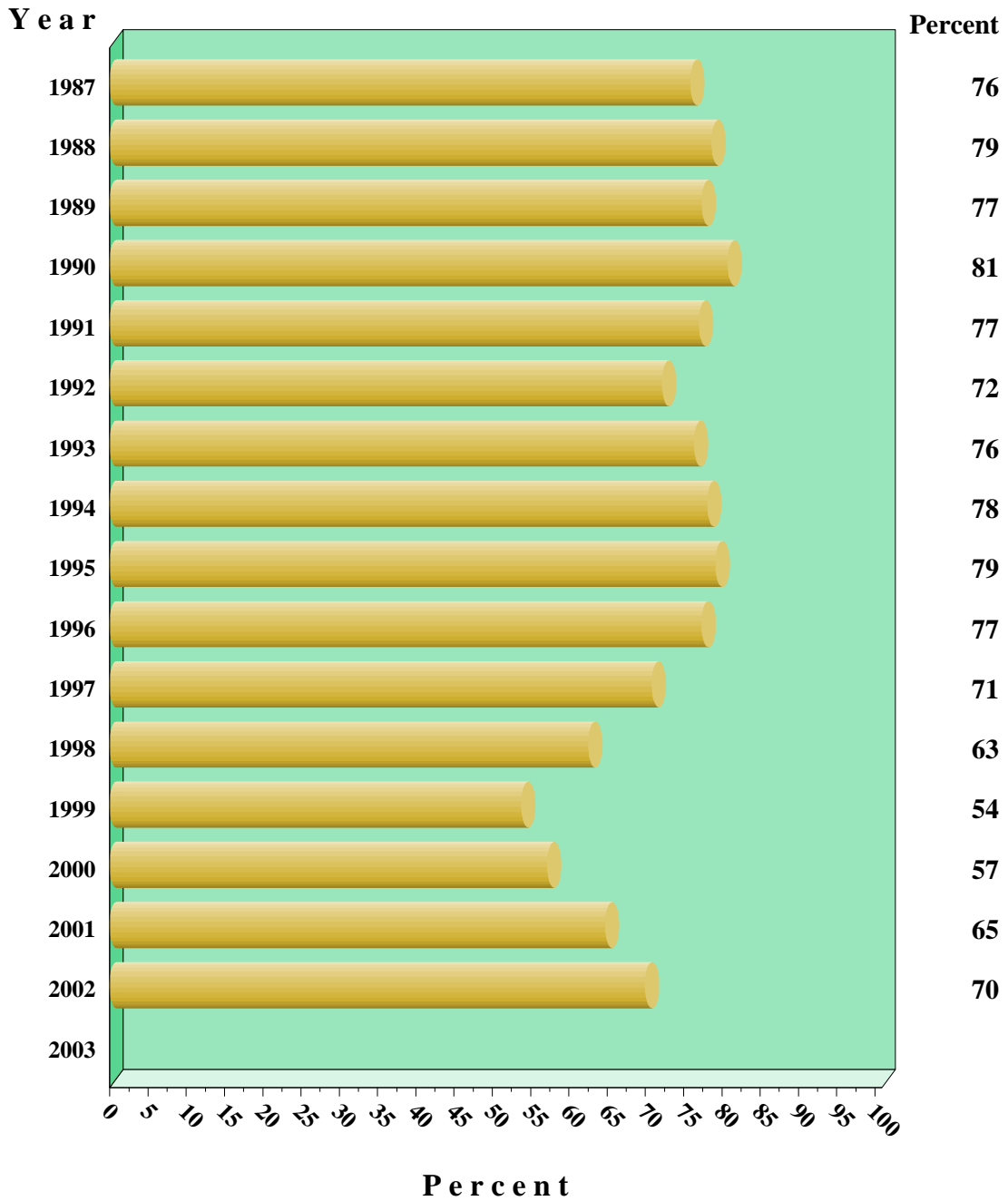

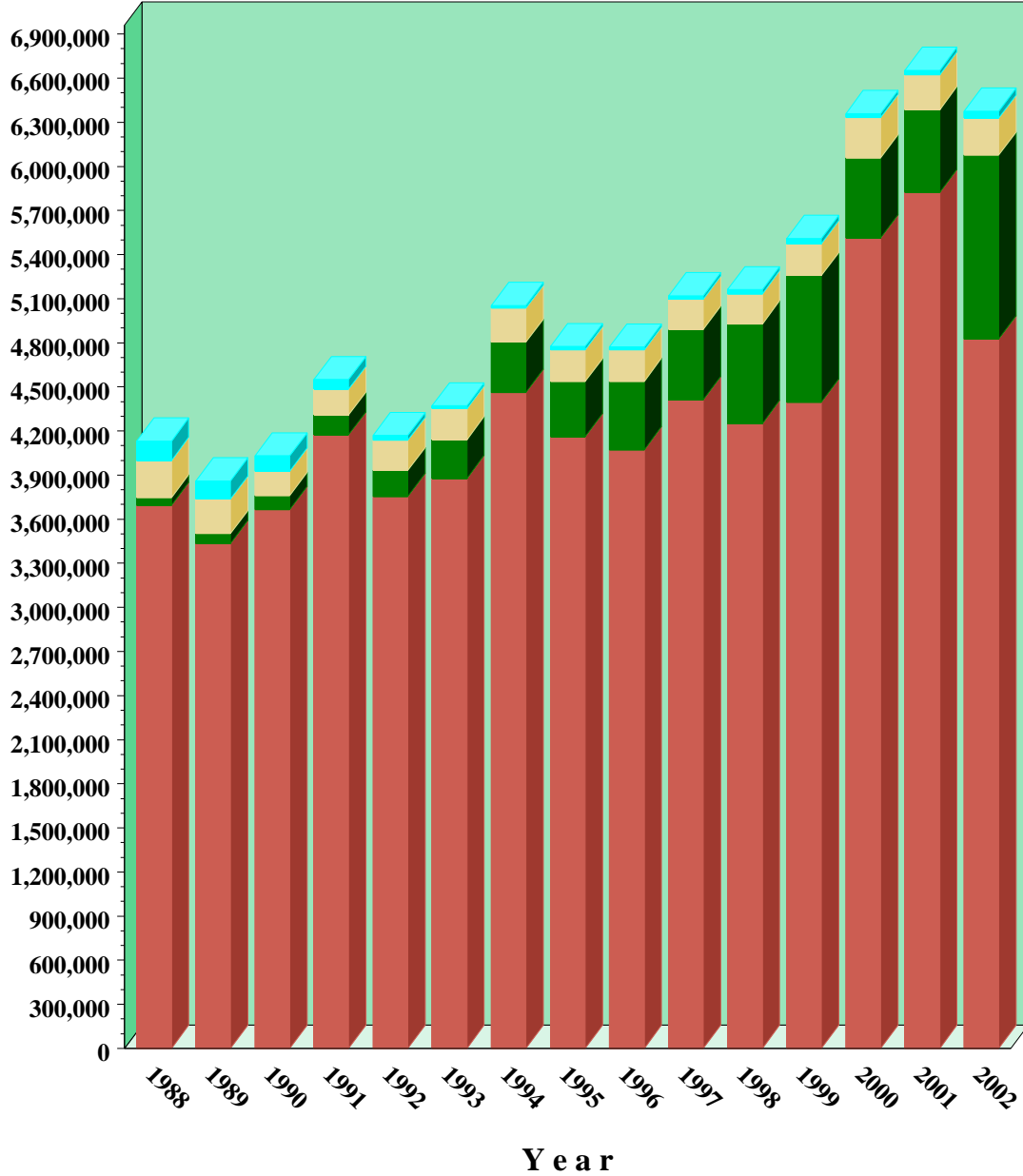
Cranberry Sales as a Percent of Total Available Supply 1987 - 2003
