

# Bog in a Cup

## care sheet

Keep soil very moist. Water daily if necessary.

Keep in direct sunlight: near a window or warm corner of the house outside.

*\*\*If outside please water twice daily to prevent soil from drying out.*

Do not allow roots to freeze, you should bring cup in during winter.

*April vacation is a good time to place cranberry cutting back outside.*

Your goal is to create the growth of tiny hair roots. This could take 4-6 weeks.

If your plant has cranberries on the vines, the fruit will eventually fall off.

*The cranberry cutting cannot support the growth of the fruit, since there aren't any hair roots yet.*
